FernLeaf Community School Major Site Plan

Matt Champion read the staff report for the major site plan application. Gregory Hoffman with CDC represented the project. The request is to construct a new 34,586SQFT public charter school on PIN: 9652-60-6938. The site will include the new structure, 137 parking spaces, 7 ADA parking spaces, 3.08 acres of impervious surfaces, and 3,497LF of new private roadway. This site will be served by City of Hendersonville public water and MSD public sewer.

Matt Champion moved to approve the major site plan for FernLeaf Community Charter School with conditions as discussed. Marcus Jones seconded the motion and all members voted in favor.

SUP-20-06 Benton Roofing Major Site Plan

Matt Champion read the staff report for the major site plan application. Tyson Griswold, PE represented the project. The request is to construct an 8,050SQFT machining and assembly operation building with an accessory use structure to house a 3,600SQFT shop and 3,600SQFT office. The site plan includes 29 parking spaces and 3 ADA parking spaces. The proposed use in the R2R zoning district requires a special use permit and will be heard during the ZBA's 12/30/20 meeting. The proposal includes use of a private well and private septic system to serve the site.

Matt Champion moved to approve the major site plan for Benton Roofing with conditions as discussed. Marcus Jones seconded the motion and all members voted in favor.
