2026 "I Voted" Sticker Contest Release Form

Eligibility:

- The sticker contest is open to all Henderson County students (public, homeschooled, private) in grades K-12.

Official Rules and Guidelines:

- The phrase "***I Voted***" must be included in the design.
- All entries must consist entirely of the student's original, non-copyrighted artwork and may not include photographs or trademarked images.
- All entries should be non-partisan and not reference any candidate, political party, or political issue.
- The Board of Elections reserves the right to disqualify any entry that is determined to contain inappropriate images or violates the contest rules.
- By entering the contest, the student is allowing the Board of Elections to use, reproduce, edit, or publish in any medium or media, for any non-commercial purpose in perpetuity.
- Artwork Guidelines:
 - The design will be sized to fit on a circular sticker two inches in diameter.
 - Designs may be created using crayons, pencils, paint, ink or any other mixed media materials.
(Digital designs will not be accepted)
- Only one entry per student.

How to Enter:

- The contest will open on March 1, 2026, and will close on Wednesday April 15, 2026.
- Entries must be submitted on the "I Voted" Sticker Contest Entry Form and may be mailed or hand delivered to: Henderson County Board of Elections located at 75 E Central St Hendersonville, NC 28792 or emailed to hcelections@hendersoncountync.gov. Entry forms may be printed off our website or picked up during normal business hours (M-F 8:30am – 5pm) at the election's office.

Winning Entry:

- There will be a winning sticker design from each grade category, K-2nd, 3rd-5th, 6th-8th, and 9th-12th selected by the Henderson County Board of Election's staff.
- The four top winners will be notified by phone/email using the contact information listed on this form.
- The winning designs will be used as Henderson County's official "I Voted" sticker for the 2026 General Election.
- Except where prohibited by law, entry constitutes permission to use all winners' names and design for promotional purposes. The design may be edited or altered to meet the guidelines of the Henderson County "I Voted" Sticker Contest for mass-production.

Permission:

- I certify and acknowledge that I have read, and I agree to the Official Rules of this contest prior to signing it. By submitting an entry, I give permission to participate in the Henderson County "I Voted" Sticker Contest and give Henderson County permission to use my name and other information for publishing on the website and social media platforms, as well as other public forums without any additional notice to or permission by me.

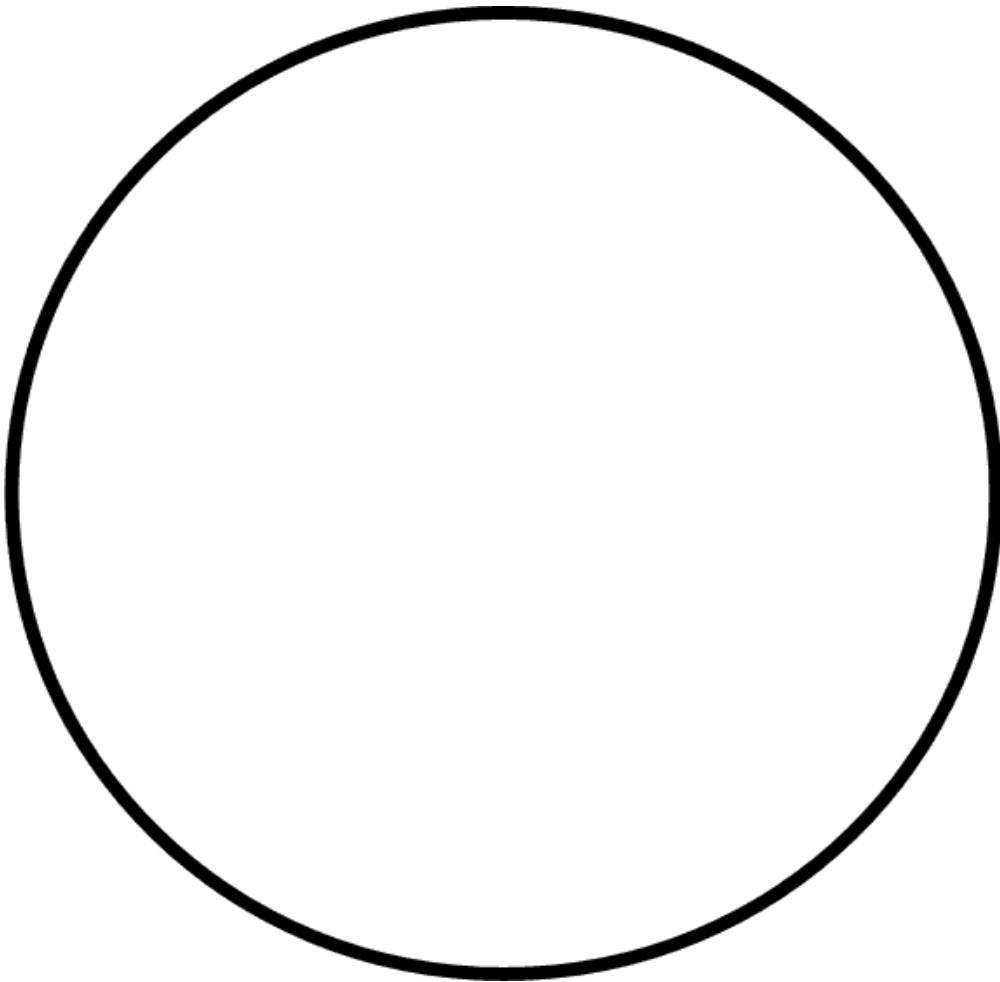
