- Use this form to request a new, duplicate, or replacement **Voter Photo Identification Card** ("Voter Photo ID Card") from your county board of elections. The Voter Photo ID Card is a form of acceptable photo ID to vote in North Carolina. For more information about photo ID requirements in North Carolina, visit ncsbe.gov/voter-id.
- Any registered voter may request a Voter Photo ID Card in the county where the voter is registered to vote. You do not need to request a Voter Photo ID Card if you already have an acceptable photo ID for voting (such as an active NC drivers license), but you may do so. Visit ncsbe.gov/voter-id to see the full list of acceptable photo IDs.
- If you are not registered to vote in the county where you now live, you must become registered to vote in that county before you submit this form.
- The Voter Photo ID Card expires 10 years from the date of issuance and is valid for voting purposes statewide in North Carolina. If you register to vote in a new county after being issued a Voter Photo ID Card, you do not need to request a new Voter Photo ID Card.

- To request a **new** Voter Photo ID Card, submit this form <u>in person</u> to your county board of elections. The county board of elections will take your photograph and issue the card to you if you are a registered voter.
- To request a **duplicate** Voter Photo ID Card because you have lost your Voter Photo ID Card or it is damaged, submit this form to your county board of elections <u>in person or by mail</u>. You may also request a duplicate card from your county board of elections <u>by telephone</u>.
- To request a **replacement** Voter Photo ID Card because your name has changed and you have updated your voter registration with your new name, submit this form to your county board of elections <u>in person or by mail</u>. You may also request a replacement card from your county board of elections <u>by telephone</u>.
- Completing this form will not change your voter registration record. If you wish to do so, please contact your county board of elections.
