SUMMARY OF REQUEST:

The City of Hendersonville has requested County comments on a proposed water line extension project to serve the Solomon's Cove development.

City of Hendersonville - Project Summary Water Line Extension Solomon's Cove

Date: November 14, 2005

This is a project to extend existing water lines to provide water service to a proposed residential development consisting of thirty five (35) lots. This project is located on Howard Gap Road, just south of Upward Road.

This project is under the reviewing jurisdiction of: Henderson County.

This project requires approximately **8,525** linear feet of water line sized as following:

Description: Approximate Length

12" DIP CL350 1900" 8" DIP CL350 3200" 6" CL350 3425"

Fire Protection will be provided by the installation of eight (8) fire hydrants. (3 hydrants on the 6" / 2 hydrants on the 12" / 3 hydrants on the 8")

The entire cost of the proposed water line extension is to be paid for by Jeff Suttles, Owner/Developer.

Water pressure and flow in this area is as follows:

Static Pressure: 60 PSI

Residual: 28 PSI Hydrant: 07-1096

Flow: 700 GPM

Based on the above information, the Water & Sewer department is capable of supporting the additional connections and recommends approval of the project contingent upon approval of the final plans and specifications from the Water & Sewer Department.
