Dear Mr. Moyer:

Please find attached eight (8) copies of the comprehensive quarterly report of the Henderson County Public Schools Capital Outlay as of March 31, 2007, for your use and distribution to County Government. The report was presented to the Henderson County Board of Public Education last night during its regular business session. Information highlighted in *yellow* represents projects that have been completed. As you will recall, we are submitting this information in response to our agreement with the Board of Commissioners to provide a current update of expenditures for capital needs on a quarterly basis.

Information printed in *red* indicates those projects that were included in the School Board's 2006-2007 budget but later cut because of a lack of funding. These projects appear in our 2007-2008 Capital Outlay Budget request. Information printed in *blue* represent projects designated for Sugarloaf Elementary School. Again, please note that \$525,000 was appropriated during FY2006-2007 specifically for the purchase of furniture (\$275,000), custodial equipment (\$30,000) and technology (\$220,000) for Sugarloaf Elementary; however, since the school will not open until August 2008, we asked that those funds be re-appropriated by the Commission.

Attached is the Capital Budget expenditures 3<sup>rd</sup> quarterly report.

The first two pages are documents presented to the Henderson County Public School Board of Education on April 16, 2007. The remaining pages indicate expenditures. The following is a list of the amount of the budget remaining and the projects to be completed:

#### Category I

\$56,000 <u>Energy Management Systems</u> – This project was bid in April, with Control Specialties, a company from Asheville being low bid. This project will complete one-half of North Henderson High School's energy management system.

\$58,208 <u>HVAC</u> – There are two projects remaining. One project is to upgrade the heating system at Hendersonville High Auditorium and the other is to improve the AC system at Marlow. The Hendersonville High project is currently being bid at this time with engineers assessing the situation at Marlow Elementary.

\$30,000 <u>ADA Requirements</u> – This is an upgrade to the fire alarm system at Balfour Education Center. Engineers are bidding the project with the goal of completing the project in early June.

\$47,377 <u>Carpet and Vinyl</u> – All of the projects have been completed. In the next quarterly report, a budget amendment will indicate the amount in this budget was moved to another account to complete a project.

#### Category II

\$222,612 <u>System Wide Technology</u> – This is the \$220,000 carryover for Sugarloaf Elementary.

\$30,365 <u>Custodial Equipment</u> - This is the \$30,000 carryover for Sugarloaf Elementary.

\$275,024 Furniture - This is the \$275,000 carryover for Sugarloaf Elementary.
