HENDERSON COUNTY ADEQUATE PUBLIC FACILITIES TASK FORCE CHARTER

What is the Task Force's purpose?

<u>To study the feasibility of implementing an Adequate Public Facilities standards into the</u> <u>Land Development Code for Henderson County. If it is determined that the County should</u> <u>proceed with the development of Adequate Public Facilities standards, then the Task Force shall</u> <u>work with Planning Staff to develop and recommend those standards.</u> To work with the <u>consultant and Planning Staff to develop and recommend an Adequate Public Facilities</u> <u>Ordinance to address public school facility issues related to growth.</u>

Who will the Task Force report to?

Board of Commissioners

Who will be staff to the Task Force?

- County Planning Staff
- Consultant (if needed)
- Other county staff as assigned

What is the duration of the Task Force's existence?

The Task Force will terminate upon final presentation of the draft ordinance to the Board of Commissioners by November 2007. The Task Force will terminate with completion of the project.

How will the future tasks or projects of the Task Force be determined?
