Justification: Please provide a brief justification for this line-item transfer request. The Emergency Management department would like to utilize \$16,346.00 from the additional EMPG funding in Capital Outlay – Equipment toward the purchase of a Polaris 6x6 all terrain vehicle with snowplow kit and trailer. In the past year we have had to utilize a bulldozer from the NC Forest Service three times to access the Bearwallow Mountain communications site. The dozer requires a full day to move to the site and clear the road to the tower. When our emergency communications fail we do not have the luxury of waiting a full day to restore communications. The all terrain vehicle and trailer will; allow us to access the remote mountain sites whenever needed regardless of weather conditions; provide a support vehicle for our EMS Special Trauma and Rescue (STAR) Team; and support lost person search and rescue missions.
