## **SUMMARY OF REQUEST:**

On June 7, 2010 the Board approved a grant from the State Energy Office for the amount of \$183,101.00. This proposal is for items for the Henderson County Lighting Retrofit project that will upgrade T12 to T8 florescent lighting and include occupancy sensors in the County. It also includes the upgrade of 72 lights in the City of Hendersonville from T8 to T5 lights. Energy savings in Henderson County are estimated at \$27,000 per year. These energy savings will be monitored and verified by a third-party hired by the State Energy Office. This project involves no local funding.

On 6/14/2010 the Request for Proposals was posted in the Hendersonville Times-News and was posted on the Henderson County website. The RFP was kept on the Henderson County website for a period of 7 days. On 6/21/2010 at 2:00 pm three bids were opened publicly. Henderson County received bids from Graybar, Blue Ridge Lighting Supply Inc. and Phillips Lighting Company. Graybar is the lowest responsible bidder with a proposal at \$98,613.80.
