SUMMARY OF REQUEST:

The Henderson County Sheriff's Office requests that the service badge and sidearm of Terry Foster be given to him in recognition of his retirement from the Henderson County Sheriff's Office.

Senior Deputy Foster began employment with the Henderson County Sheriff's Office on January 31, 1989, as a Jailer and held the ranks of Detention Officer, Deputy, Senior Deputy, Corporal, Sergeant, and Lieutenant. Senior Deputy Foster has served for a total of 27 years in the Sheriff's Office. He has spent his adult life serving our community and agency. To honor him and show my gratitude, the Sheriff's Department intends to present his service badge and service sidearm to him.

Resolution Honoring Senior Deputy Terry Foster



For 27 Years of Law Enforcement Service and Awarding Him His Badge and Sidearm

WHEREAS, Senior Deputy Foster joined the Henderson County Sheriff's Office as a Jailer on January 31, 1989 and held the ranks of Jailer, Detention Officer, Deputy, Senior Deputy, Corporal, Sergeant, and Lieutenant; and

WHEREAS, Senior Deputy Foster's service and dedication to the Henderson County Sheriff's Office and service, dedication and accomplishments in the field of law enforcement during his 27 years of service are hereby recognized and commended; and

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S. 20-187.2 provides that retiring officers of the Henderson County Sheriff's Office may receive, at the time of their retirement, the badge worn or carried by them during their service with Henderson County; and

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S. 20-187.2 further provides that the Henderson County Board of Commissioners may, in its discretion, award to a retiring officer the service sidearm of such retiring officer at a price determined by the Board of Commissioners, upon securing a permit as required by N.C.G.S. 14-402 et seq; and

WHEREAS, Senior Deputy Foster has served as a member of the Henderson County Sheriff's Office for a period of more than 27 years and retired from the Henderson County Sheriff's Office on July 15, 2016; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Henderson County Board of Commissioners as follows:

- Sheriff Charles McDonald is hereby authorized in accordance with the provisions of N.C.G.S. 20-187.2 to transfer to Senior Deputy Foster the badge worn by him during his service with the Henderson County Sheriff's Office; and
- 2. Sheriff McDonald is hereby authorized in accordance with the provisions of N.C.G.S. 20-187.2 to transfer to Senior Deputy Foster his service sidearm at no cost to the officer and upon his securing a permit required by N.C.G.S. 14-402.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Henderson County Board of Commissioners recognizes and thanks Senior Deputy Foster for his dedicated service to Henderson County and its citizens.
