ACPT Response to COVID-19

Updated in response to NC Executive Order 180

As a function of Henderson County government, Apple Country Public Transit is making a concerted effort to quell the spread of COVID-19 while continuing to offer a critical community service. <u>Until further notice</u>, the following policies apply to all services of ACPT:

- Face masks are required. Masks must cover mouth and nose. Children under 5 and people who have a medical or behavioral condition or disability are not required to wear one. *
- Riders who refuse to comply will be denied service.
- Riders should practice "social distancing" and spread out on the bus when possible.
- Riders should limit their travel to **essential trips.**
- Riders who have traveled a full route rotation without leaving must exit the bus at the transfer station or pay for a second trip.
