
Thank you for contacting me about the President's health care law. I appreciate receiving a copy of Henderson County's March 4th resolution.

I believe that we need to repeal the health care law. The American people have made it clear that they do not want this new law, which imposes cuts to Medicare, dramatically increases federal spending and taxes, expands the scope and size of the federal government, and puts bureaucrats between patients and their doctors.

You may be pleased to learn that I am a cosponsor of the ObamaCare Repeal Act (S. 177), legislation introduced by Senator Ted Cruz (R-TX) to repeal ObamaCare entirely. If Congress cannot enact a straight repeal, then we must do what we can to defund the health care law.


On behalf of the Henderson County North Carolina Board of Commissioners, I hereby submit a formal petition seeking a waiver for the Henderson County government from all unfunded mandates and unwarranted double taxation imposed under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA).

The Henderson County government has diligently worked to provide all of its department employees and their families with substantial healthcare benefits at a manageable cost. Under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, Henderson County will be subjected to double taxation, unjustifiable fees and additional costs due to relaxed eligibility requirements. These increased costs will create an undue financial burden on the local government that will inevitably be borne by the taxpayers of Henderson County.

The Patient Protect and Affordable Care Act, in its current form, will undoubtedly break state and local government budgets and magnify the most costly aspects of our healthcare system. I ask that you waive the law's costly mandates and grant Henderson County the ability to choose benefit rules that meet the specific needs of the county.

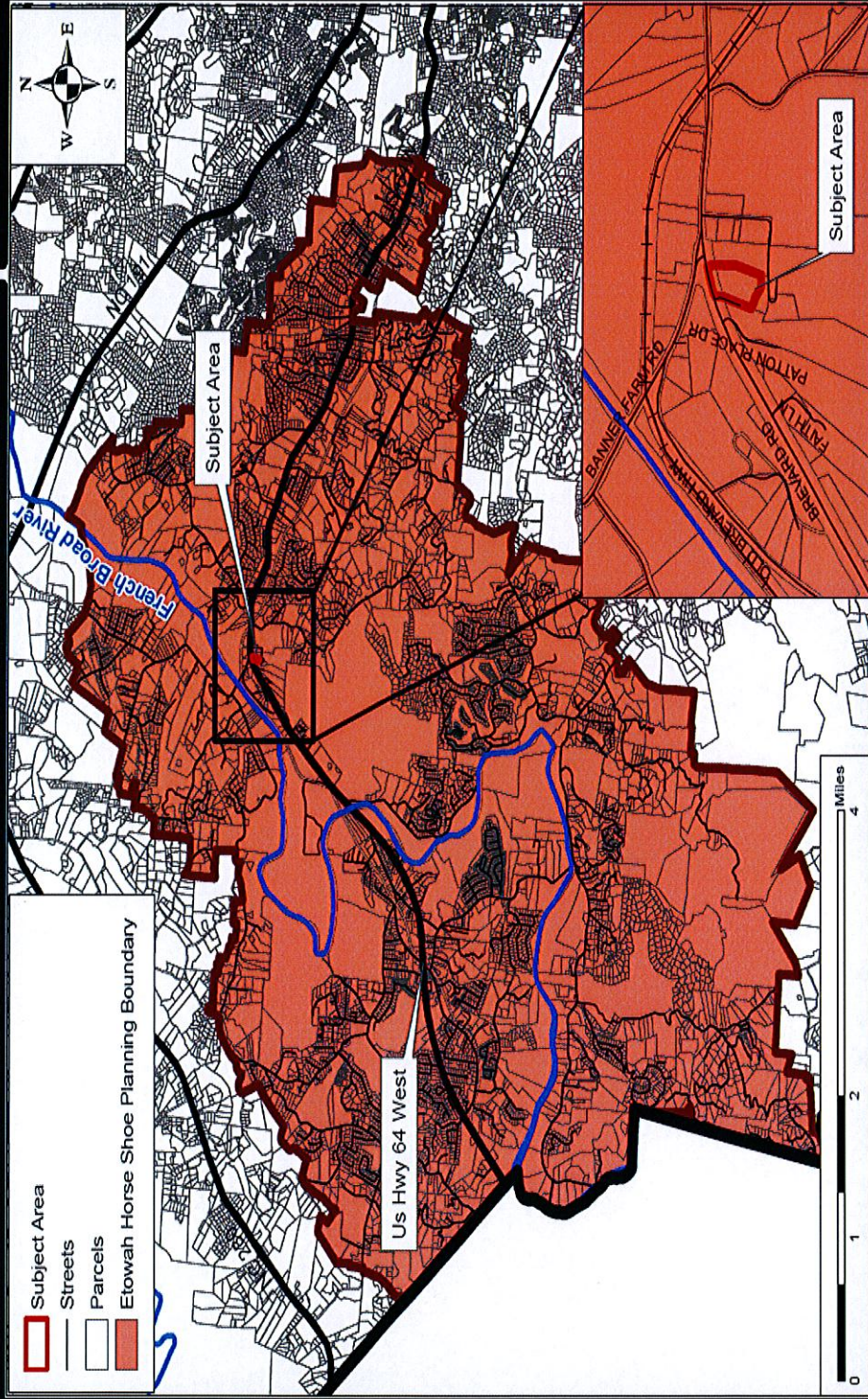
