MINUTES

STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA COUNTY OF HENDERSON

BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS February 21, 1996

The Henderson County Board of Commissioners met for a regularly scheduled meeting at 9:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Conference Room of the Henderson County Office Building.

Those present were: Chairman Renee Kumor, Vice-Chairman Vollie G. Good, Commissioner Robert D. Eklund, Commissioner J. Michael Edney, County Manager David F. Thompson, Assistant County Manager David E. Nicholson, County Attorney Don H. Elkins, Staff Attorney Angela Skerrett, and Clerk to the Board Elizabeth W. Corn.

Commissioner Ward came in late during REQUEST TO SET A PUBLIC HEARING FOR PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ROAD NAMES.

Also present were: Finance Director Carey McLelland, Planning Director Matt Matteson, and Budget Analyst Selena Coffey.

CALL TO ORDER/WELCOME

Chairman Kumor called the meeting to order and welcomed all in attendance.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Commissioner Eklund led the pledge to the American Flag.

INVOCATION

Chaplain Jane McKowan of Hospice gave the invocation.

DISCUSSION/ADJUSTMENT OF AGENDA

Additions were:

Resolution

Sewer System Plan School CIP Forms

Mr. Thompson stated that the Codification work session had been canceled for this afternoon. He had substituted a short CIP work session to receive the results of the latest rankings.

CONSENT AGENDA

Commissioner Eklund made the motion to approve the Consent Agenda as presented. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

The Consent Agenda included the following:

Proclamation - Kiwanis Club of Hendersonville Week March 17-23, 1996

Richard Rhodes, Vice-President of WHKP Radio, requested Board action to proclaim the week of March 17-23 as Kiwanis Club of Hendersonville Week. The local Kiwanis Club will celebrate its 75th year of serving Henderson County on March 23, 1996.

Proclamation of a County State of Emergency Proclamation Terminating a County State of Emergency

Due to the recent storm and complications associated with that storm, a State of Emergency was called February 3, 1996 and was terminated February 7, 1996.

Because this was a serious and a unique experience for Henderson County, it was decided that it would be beneficial to make these two documents part of the official meeting of February 21, 1996. This allows us to have a historical record of the transaction.

A motion was necessary to incorporate these two documents into the minutes of today's meeting.

Henderson County Public Schools Financial Report

The monthly financial report was presented for December 1995 for information only.

INFORMAL PUBLIC COMMENTS

1.Ken Weitzen read a letter on behalf of the Land Use Plan Steering Committee. It was the committee's unanimous recommendation that the County Commissioners adopt a county-wide land use guidance system (LUGS). The Board had decided against LUGS. The committee members had questions as to why LUGS was not adopted, etc.

PUBLIC HEARING - 21 CENTURY WAREHOUSE

Commissioner Good made the motion for the Board to go into Public Hearing. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Angela Skerrett reminded the Board that this Public Hearing was held pursuant to N.C.G.S. 158-7.1 to consider the request of 21st Century Warehouse for assistance in the amount of \$22,000.00 as a partial reimbursement for the cost of a waterline to serve 21st Century Warehouse. 21st Century Warehouse is an industrial warehousing operation which has recently located on Crest Road in Henderson County. 21st Century has made a capital investment of over \$1.0 Million, including building, equipment, and land. They plan to expand their facility over the next four (4) years with an additional capital investment of \$2.9 Million. 21st Century Warehouse employees two (2) persons, and plans to have a total number of 15-20 at the end of four (4) years. The total cost of the waterline installation was \$66,867.85, including engineering expenses. The Agreement sets out the economic development responsibilities of 21st Century Warehouse. Staff recommended that the Board approve this but authorize the Chairman to execute the agreement only after the incorporation of 21st Century Warehouse has been finalized, and required payment be made only after execution of the agreement by both Henderson County and 21st Century Warehouse.

Ms. Skerrett recognized two representatives from 21st Century Warehouse, Mr. Dan Teeter and Adrianne Justus.

Ms. Skerrett reviewed the agreement and made one change that 21st Century Warehouse had requested. To date 21st Century Warehouse has not finalized their incorporation process.

Public Input

There was none.

Commissioner Good made the motion for the Board to go out of Public hearing. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

It was the consensus of the Board to wait to take action on this after Commissioner Don Ward arrived.

PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER AN AMENDMENT TO THE AMBULANCE ORDINANCE Commissioner Eklund made the motion for the Board to go into Public Hearing. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Ms. Skerrett reminded the Board that this Public Hearing was held as required by N.C.G.S. 193A-250 to consider an Amendment to the "Ordinance for the Operation of Ambulance Service in Henderson County, North Carolina." The proposed amendment requires a franchise's rate of service to be less than or equal to that charged by Henderson County.

Notice of today's Public Hearing was placed in the Times News on February 6, 1996 and February 13, 1996 in conformance with NCGS 153A-250.

Public Input

There was none.

Commissioner Good made the motion to close the Public Hearing. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Commissioner Good made the motion to approve the amendment to the Ambulance Ordinance. A vote was taken which was unanimous (4).

REQUEST TO SET A PUBLIC HEARING FOR PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ROAD NAMES The Property Address Coordinator anticipated having approximately 100 street names ready for consideration. It was requested that the Board set a Public Hearing for April 1, 1996.

A work session was set for 6:00 p.m. on April 1. Commissioner Good made the motion to set a Public Hearing for April 1 at 7:00 p.m. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Commissioner Ward arrived during the presentation of this item and voted on it.

21st Century Warehouse The Board had delayed action on this until after Commissioner Ward arrived. Following some discussion,

Commissioner Edney made the motion to approve the request but not to sign it until the Corporation has been legally created. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

APPEAL OF PLANNING BOARD'S DENIAL OF PRELIMINARY PLAN SUBMITTED BY GRANT MOUNTAIN PROPERTIES CORPORATION, INC.

Action was taken at the Henderson County Planning Board on January 30, 1996 concerning the preliminary plan for Stoneridge Estates. Angela Skerrett stated that Attorney Craig Justus was present on behalf of the developer, Grant Mountain Properties. Ms. Skerrett and Mr. Justus had discussed that rather than having the evidentiary hearing that they would submit stipulated FINDINGS OF FACT. Mr. Elkins indicated that would be appropriate.

Following much discussion, Commissioner Edney made the motion to authorize preliminary Plan Approval of Phases 2A and 2B, adopt the FINDINGS OF FACT as discussed with revisions, adopt the CONCLUSIONS as revised and adopt the ORDER as revised. A vote was taken and the motion carried three to two with Commissioners Kumor and Ward voting nay.

The FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS, and ORDER are attached as part of these minutes.

VOLUNTEER WATER INFORMATION NETWORK (VWIN) ANNUAL REPORT

Michele Skeele, VWIN Volunteer Coordinator presented the annual report and answered questions. She recognized several volunteers in the audience.

The Board of Commissioners accepted the report.

She stated that we have low alkalinity in our streams in Henderson County. The Mills River and Green River have the lowest maximum readings in total suspended solids making them the least disturbed watershed sites.

Biological testing is not done but is now available. The costs for such testing would include administrative, training of volunteers and purchasing of equipment and generating the reports. The Board asked what the cost would be for the biological testing. Ms. Skeele did not have that figure readily available but stated that the Board would receive that information within the next month.

David Thompson - Announcement

Mr. Thompson showed some baseball style caps and stated that they are getting some made up for each of the Commissioners. The back of the cap will say 1996 ICE STORM SUPPORT TEAM. He presented a cap to the Chairman.

Mr. Thompson said that approx. 300 people were thanked with formal letters from the Chairman, Rocky's office, and the County Manager's office. They forgot to thank the County Commissioners and therefore will have the caps printed to thank the Commissioners.

REPORT OF ACTIVITIES for "ICE STORM 96"

Rocky Hyder, County Fire Marshal and Emergency Management Coordinator, briefed the Board on the report. In summary, a total of 50 agencies responded to "Ice Storm 95" devoting over 16,000 man hours to the response effort, representing a work force equivalent to 148 people 24 hours a day. This was extraordinary.

REQUEST FOR APPROVAL, HENDERSON COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE AND HENDERSON COUNTY STATE OF EMERGENCY ORDINANCE
Rocky Hyder stated that these Ordinances are an essential part of an integrated Emergency Management system and basically serve as the foundation of the Emergency Management Program.

The Henderson County Emergency Management Ordinance establishes the Emergency Management Office and defines the authority and responsibilities of the Emergency Management Coordinator. reference: N.C.G.S. 166A)

The General Statutes do not require a public hearing before adoption of these Ordinances. The Board of Commissioners requested public input before adopting the two Resolutions.

Mr. Hyder and Mr. Thompson both agreed that lessons were learned during the recent ice storm and there are some things they would do differently for the next disaster. There was some discussion regarding a curfew.

A Public Hearing will be set during Important Dates on the County State of Emergency Ordinance. The Board also suggested the need for a work session.

Commissioner Eklund made the motion to approve the basic plan for the HENDERSON COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE. Commissioner

Edney requested the vote be delayed until afternoon. He wanted time to review the Ordinance before voting. This was agreeable.

Chairman Kumor called a 10 minute recess.

PRESENTATION ON MILLS RIVER WATER TREATMENT FACILITY

Bill Lapsley made a presentation on Mills River Water Treatment Facility. Yesterday at the regular monthly meeting of the Asheville Buncombe Water Authority, Mr. Thompson and Commissioner Edney were in attendance and witnessed a presentation by the Consulting Engineer hired by the Asheville Buncombe Water Authority to design the Mills River Regional Water Treatment Facility.

Mr. Lapsley made the presentation on behalf of Camp, Dresser & McKee which is the environmental engineering firm. They are the consultant of record for the project.

While Mr. Lapsley set up for the presentation, Mr. Edney brought up the next agenda item.

RESOLUTION IN MEMORY OF WILLIAM DEBRUHL

Commissioner Edney informed the Board that ABWA member William DeBruhl passed away recently. At the ABWA meeting yesterday, the ABWA adopted a similar Resolution . The Resolution calls on the City of Asheville to rename the Bee Tree Water Treatment Plant the "William DeBruhl Water Treatment Facility at Bee Tree Lake". Mr. Edney passed around a Resolution in Memory of William Debruhl and asked for Board adoption.

Commissioner Edney made the motion that the Henderson County Board of Commissioners adopt the Resolution in Memory of William Debruhl. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Mills River Water Treatment Facility

Mr. Lapsley finished his presentation using maps and charts. The entrance to the facility is opposite School House Road. There is a separate service entrance and also a maintenance entrance. The finished water comes out of the plant and goes into a clear well, through a high service pump station and pumped into the distribution system. He showed a floor plan of the main building.

Mr. Lapsley stated that the treatment facility is state of the art, the best technology available around the world. A special feature of the plant is an Education Center, a facility available for

community meetings and a stop for school children to learn about the water treatment process or ecology of the watershed. There is an auditorium as part of the education center. It has a separate entrance from the main entrance to the plant and has restroom facilities. The plant is designed for future expansions.

This route was chosen for the following main reasons:

- 1. It is pretty close to the shortest route possible back to the system.
- 2. Not to parallel existing City of Hendersonville lines, no duplication of service.
- 3. So this transmission main could open up areas of Henderson County that are not currently served by public water supply (distribution line).
- 4. It puts all of the line on publicly maintained road right-of-way.

The preliminary construction cost estimates for this project:

Including contingencies and escalation during the construction period, the ABWA is faced with a \$26,120,000 project.

Camp, Dresser, & McKee is in their final design stage and permitting phase. They started last fall with the design of the water plant intake and the transmission main. They are about 65% finished with the final plans and specifications and they expect 90% completion of the plans and specs in April. The plans will be sent to the State for permits to authorize construction by the first of June. The go to bid phase will be June and July. Construction should begin in August of 1996. It will take approximately 2 years to build the facility and put it on line. The transmission main will take about a one year. When the treatment plant is finished, the transmission main will be put in service.

Commissioner Edney added that there will be a park designed as part of the project.

PROGRAM AND FACILITY FEES AND USE POLICY FOR THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT

Larry Harmon, Parks and Recreation Director, recommended slight increases to some existing programs and new fees be set for new programs and facilities. The recreation department felt that the fees and charges for recreation program participation and rental of recreation facilities needs to be revised in order to keep up with rising costs. Most of the fees are recommended to stay the same.

Mr. Harmon reviewed the changes in fees he recommended:

Rental of shelters increased.			

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There also were some new programs reviewed with fees for those programs.

There was much discussion regarding the rental fees and times, half day versus full day, etc.

Adjourn to Lunch

The Chairman adjourned the meeting to BonClarken for the Annual Employee Awards Luncheon.

Discussion resumed regarding Parks & Recreation fees. It was the consensus of the Board to recommend half day rentals for the shelters, 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. or 4:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. The Board asked that this be tried through the summer. If it causes a problem, it can be changed later. It was also the consensus of the Board that the Director of the Recreation Dept. be authorized to waive or adjust fees stated herein based on a participant's ability to pay. On page nine of the policy the Board wanted "any variance of times must be approved by the Henderson County Board of Commissioners" rather than by the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board. They also suggested a slight change in Private Gain on page nine.

With the changes stated, Commissioner Edney made the motion to adopt the policy and authorize the Manager go through to make sure there are no other technical corrections needed. A vote was taken and the motion carried four to one with Commissioner Good voting nay.

OFFER TO PURCHASE/FORECLOSED PROPERTY

County Attorney Don Elkins presented this Offer to Purchase property foreclosed in the name of Henderson County. The original bid was in November 1995 in the amount of \$1200. The high bid now is for \$6,500 from Lorimar and Daniela Keathley. Previous owner of the property was Barbara Dee Connor. This is a vacant lot in Osceola Lake, lot #12, block #18, PIN#01-02717.

Mr. Elkins recommended approval.

Commissioner Edney made the motion to approve the RESOLUTION FINAL APPROVAL OF OFFER AND AUTHORIZATION OF SALE. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

UPDATE ON PENDING ISSUES/Request for Direction to the Chair

I-26/Upward Road Study Area. Following discussion, Commissioner Edney made the motion to not zone the proposed study area. A vote was taken and the motion carried four to one with Chairman Kumor voting nay. Ms. Kumor feels that some kind of zoning should be done in the area of the Upward Elementary School to protect the County's investment there.

Erosion Control - Following very much discussion, Chairman Kumor was directed to send letters to our State Legislators regarding the Board's concern over erosion control in our area and the State's number of employees to enforce the regulations.

"LUGS" - Following discussion, Chairman Kumor was directed to send a letter to the Land Use Plan Steering Committee thanking them for their service. No further projects were available to work on at this time. LUGS has not been adopted, but it has not been abandoned as yet.

Land Development Ordinance - The Board of Commissioners will take a close look at this Ordinance and decide where and how to proceed with implementation. Review steps have already been taken. A subcommittee has been reviewing and reconstructing this ordinance.

NOMINATIONS

Chairman Kumor reminded the Board of the following vacancies and opened the floor to nominations. There were no nominations/appointments made today. All these were rolled to the next meeting.

Henderson County Zoning Board of Adjustment - 1 vac.

Henderson County Board of Health - 1 vac.

Senior Companion Program Advisory Council of Land-Of-Sky Regional Council - 3 vac.

Motor Vehicle Valuation Review Board - 4 vac.

Nursing/Adult Care Home Community Advisory Committee - 3 vac.

Board of Equalization & Review - all members.

Chairman Kumor appointed Commissioners Edney and Good as a subcommittee to take some comments from the members and develop a proposed new Board of Equalization and Review. They will act as a subcommittee. They will bring back a slate for the Board of E & R at the mid-month March meeting. They will receive nominations informally from Commissioners.

Commissioner Ward raised a concern that we are developing parks in areas of the county that do not have representation on the Recreation Advisory Committee. He also thought that there should be representation from Little League. Commissioner Ward will work with Ms. Kumor as a subcommittee to bring back a recommendation to the Board.

IMPORTANT DATES

A Work Session was added on Private Road Names for April 1, at 6:00 p.m. and a Public Hearing on Private Road Names for April 1, at 7:00 p.m.

A work session was set on the State of Emergency Ordinance for April 17, 1997.

CIP WORK SESSION

Angela Skerrett had collected ranking sheets from all the Commissioners regarding the Etowah Park and the East Flat Rock Park. The group average on Etowah Park was 8.8 and the group

average on East Flat Rock Park was 8.4. Etowah Park had a raw score of 390.8 and East Flat Rock Park 368.4.

She passed around new SUMMARY OF RATINGS ASSIGNED TO CIP PROPOSALS RECEIVED FY96-97 and assigned the three school projects to a letter so they could be ranked:

- "E" North Henderson
- "L" New Elementary School
- "M" Elementary School Additions & Renovations

The Commissioners will take home ranking charts on the three school projects and rank them individually and return them to Ms. Skerrett. She will tally the rankings and bring them back to the Board.

Henderson County Emergency Management Ordinance - Commissioner Edney raised some questions regarding wording of the Ordinance. Don Elkins recommended that this Ordinance not be adopted today. He had not reviewed the Ordinance in its entirety nor had the Commissioners.

The Planned Codification Work Session was not held.

CLOSED SESSION

Commissioner Eklund made the motion for the Board to go into Closed Session as allowed under NCGS 143-318.11 for the following reasons:

- 1. (a) (3) To consult with an attorney employed or retained by the public body in order to preserve the attorney-client privilege between the attorney and the public body, which privilege is hereby acknowledged. To consult with an attorney employed or retained by the public body in order to consider and give instructions to the attorney with respect to a claim.
- 2. (a) (5) To establish, or to instruct the public body's staff or negotiating agents concerning the position to be taken by or on behalf of the public body in negotiating (1) the price and other material terms of a contract or proposed contract for the acquisition of real property by purchase, option, exchange or lease.

All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Commissioner Ward made the motion for the Board to go out of Closed Session. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

ACTION FOLLOWING CLOSED SESSION

- 1. Subcommittee Bob Eklund and Renee Kumor were appointed as a subcommittee to review and study Multipurpose Center progress and steps needed to proceed. It was the consensus of the Board to name a Steering Committee who will then present a proposal for CIP for the Multipurpose Center.
- 2. Telecommunications The Board authorized the Chairman to communicate with the municipalities regarding combined telecommunications. County staff will bring a proposal back to the Board on how it will work.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at approximately 4:15 p.m.
