PROPOSED MANUFACTURED HOME PARK ORDINANCE

There was much discussion. The Board directed staff to revise the Ordinance to address only issues of public health, safety and welfare and bring the revised Ordinance back to the Board for review.

The special called meeting was adjourned for the Commissioners to have dinner before the regularly scheduled 7:00 p.m. meeting.


