## STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA COUNTY OF HENDERSON

BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MARCH 7, 1994

The Henderson County Board of Commissioners met for a regularly scheduled meeting at 7:00 p.m. in the Commissioners' Conference Room of the Henderson County Office Building.

Those present were: Commissioner J. Michael Edney, Commissioner Hugh D. Randall, Commissioner William McKay, Assistant County Manager David E. Nicholson, County Attorney Don H. Elkins, Finance Director Carey McLelland, and Clerk to the Board Elizabeth W. Corn.

Absent were: Chairman Vollie G. Good, Vice-Chair Renee Kumor, County Manager David F. Thompson, and Staff Attorney Angela M. Skerrett. All four were attending the NACo Conference in Washington, D.C.

## CALL TO ORDER/WELCOME

Clerk to the Board Elizabeth W. Corn called the meeting to order and welcomed all in attendance.

## ELECTION OF A TEMPORARY CHAIRMAN

Elizabeth Corn opened the floor for nominations.

Commissioner Edney nominated Commissioner McKay. Commissioner McKay nominated Commissioner Edney. There were no other nominations.

The Clerk polled the Board:

Commissioner Edney voted for Commissioner McKay. Commissioner McKay voted for Commissioner Edney. Commissioner Randall voted for Commissioner Edney.

Commissioner Edney was elected temporary Chair for the meeting.

## PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Commissioner McKay led the Pledge to the American Flag.

#### INVOCATION

Harold McKinnish, Interim Pastor of Tuxedo First Baptist Church, gave the invocation.

## DISCUSSION/ADJUSTMENT OF AGENDA

David Nicholson added #3 to "E" under Consent Agenda; Road Petitions: 3. McElrath Road.

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## CONSENT AGENDA

Commissioner Randall made the motion to approve the consent agenda as presented. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

CONSENT AGENDA included:

Review of Minutes - Minutes were presented for approval of the following meetings: December 6, 1993; February 7, 1994; and February 16, 1994.

<u>Tax Release Requests</u> - An accumulation of twenty-two (22) release requests was submitted for the Board's approval. The County Assessor has reviewed each request and supporting documentation is on file in his office.

<u>Tax Refund Requests</u> - An accumulation of four (4) refund requests was submitted for the Board's approval. The County Assessor has reviewed each request and supporting documentation is on file in his office.

Notification of Vacancy - 1 vacancy, due to resignation, on the Henderson County Nursing Home/Domiciliary Home Advisory Committee. This was presented for information only; it will be under "nominations" on the next agenda.

Road Petitions - Three petitions have been received from residents for addition of the following roads to the state maintenance system:

1. Chestnut Lane

- 2. Mockingbird Drive
- 3. McElrath Road

Request for Subdivision Improvement Guarantees - Berry Hill Subdivision - W. Rick McFalls has submitted an application for approval of an improvement guarantee for applying gravel to Berry Hill Drive in Berry Hill Subdivision. Mr. McFalls intends to provide a certified check to the County in the amount of \$4,375.00 which includes a 25% overhead factor. A draft agreement was provided.

## INFORMAL PUBLIC COMMENTS

1. Bert Browning - Mr. Browning spoke as a representative and resident of Hawthorn Hills. He spoke about a run-off problem from Carriage Park onto his property and neighbors. There was a bad silt problem in November of '93 but the recent rains have produced 2-3 times the washing and silt as the November problem. He wanted to advise the Board of the problem since the Board will be considering the approval of an expansion of Carriage Park in the future.

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# Assistant County Manager's Statement

David Nicholson informed all that the County has no responsibility on erosion control, the State does. As county government we need to assist our citizens when they have a problem working with the state or with their neighbors. The County Manager has asked the Planning Director to be meeting with the citizens as well as the State Representatives. Hopefully a report will be ready to present to the Board on March 16 about what has been found.

2. Joe Hope - Mr. Hope also spoke about an on-going problem of silt and washing from the Carriage Park construction. The State has been involved but Mr. Hope feels that their standards are not adequate. Mr. Hope distributed pictures of the mud and washing problem.

# <u>PUBLIC HEARING - Rezoning Request to O & I for Highland Lake Conference Center</u>

Commissioner McKay made the motion to go into Public Hearing. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Matt Matteson stated that this is a request to zone a 110 acre site owned by Highland Lake Conference Center, which is presented zone R-40, R-10, R-20, and C-1, to Office & Institutional (0 & I). O & I Zoning District allows Conference Centers with conditional uses.

# Public Input

- 1. Kerry Lindsey Mr. Lindsey is the petitioner and was available to answer questions. He stated that they would like to expand their facilities.
- 2. Andy Krause Mr. Krause is the new General Manager at Highland Lake. He just recently moved to the area.
- 3. Michael Ruff Mr. Ruff is a neighbor of Highland Lake and wished to see a map so he would know if he will be rezoned with this request. He is directly across the road from part of the Highland Lake property and asked what would be done with the Conference Center property across from him.

Mr. Ruff was satisfied with the intended use of the property across from his property. The rezoning will not affect Mr. Ruff's property.

After some discussion, Commissioner Randall made the motion to close the Public Hearing. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Chairman Edney announced that no action will be taken on this item until the March 16 meeting.

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# PUBLIC HEARING - Purchase of 0.0905 acre parcel and 0.2834 acre parcel of Property of the Appleland Industrial Park

Commissioner McKay made the motion to go into Public Hearing. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

David Nicholson reminded the Board that these are two very small pieces of land that are located on Upward Road. The county will deed these two pieces of land to N.C. Department of Transportation. The County's purchase price for the 0.0905 acre parcel is \$9,050.00 and the purchase price for the 0.2834 acre parcel is \$4,567.68.

Public Input - There was none.

Commissioner McKay made the motion to close Public Hearing. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

# <u>PUBLIC HEARING - Renewal of the Option to Purchase 69.4 acres of the Appleland Business Park</u>

Commissioner Randall made the motion to go into Public Hearing. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

David Nicholson reminded the Board that this Public Hearing is regarding the renewal of the option on the land for the Appleland Business Park. Our options are in three month segments. The current option will end at the end of March. Renewal of the option will go through the end of June. The County must pay a quarterly interest rate on the outstanding balance. The payment will be somewhere in the vicinity of \$20,000 - \$25,000.

Public Input - There was none.

Commissioner McKay made the motion to close the Public Hearing. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Chairman Edney stated that action would be taken at the end of the agenda, before the close of the meeting.

## SHEPHERD STREET REZONING REQUEST

David Nicholson informed the Board that the request is to schedule a Public Hearing. Request is to rezone two parcels on Shepherd Street from R-15 to I-2. Suggested Public Hearing date was April 4, 1994.

Commissioner McKay made the motion to set the Public Hearing for April 4, 1994 at 7:00 p.m. on the Shepherd Street Rezoning Request. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

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## FORECLOSED PROPERTY OF JOHN HEATH & WIFE

Don Elkins informed the Board of an Offer to Purchase from Joseph Huntley in the amount of \$350.00. The bidders currently own no interest in the property and are of no relation to the prior owner. This Offer to Purchase was presented to the Board for proposed acceptance.

After some discussion, Commissioner McKay made the motion to accept the offer and advertise for upset bids. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

## BOARD OF EQUALIZATION & REVIEW

Chairman Edney informed the Board that these appointments must be made at this meeting, pursuant to statutes and a local bill.

Commissioner McKay nominated:

R.E. Harmon (as Chairman), Leon Lamb, Glenn Mullinax, Doris Saltz, and Marvin B. Smith as full members. As alternates: Marlene Conner, Blanche Grace, and Becky King. All these individuals have agreed to continue to serve. There were no other nominations.

Commissioner Randall made the motion to suspend the rules and make all eight appointments. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

The Watershed Work Session originally scheduled for 7:00 p.m. on March 10 has been rescheduled for 7:00 p.m. on March 21.

Commissioner McKay made the motion to call a special meeting of the Board of Commissioners for March 10 at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall to discuss Annexation. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

The Board adjourned as the Henderson County Board of Commissioners and convened as Cane Creek Water & Sewer District.
