# STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA COUNTY OF HENDERSON

BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS DECEMBER 2, 1991

The Henderson County Board of Commissioners met for a regularly scheduled meeting at 7:00 p.m. in the Commissioners' Meeting Room of the Henderson County Office Building.

Those present were: Chairman J. Michael Edney, Vice-Chairman Vollie G. Good, Commissioner F. Richard Baker, Commissioner Hugh D. Randall, Commissioner William McKay, Assistant County Manager/Finance Director David E. Nicholson, County Attorney Don H. Elkins, and Clerk to the Board Elizabeth W. Corn. Absent was County Manager David F. Thompson.

## CALL TO ORDER/WELCOME

Chairman Edney called the meeting to order and welcomed all in attendance.

## PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Commissioner Good led in the pledge to the American Flag.

## INVOCATION

Commissioner McKay gave the invocation.

## ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN AND VICE-CHAIRMAN

Chairman Edney informed the Board that at the first meeting in December each year the first order of business is the election of the Chairman and Vice-Chairman. He opened the floor for nominations.

<u>Chairman</u> - Commissioner Randall nominated Commissioner McKay for Chairman. Commissioner Baker nominated Chairman Edney. There were no other nominations. A vote was taken as follows:

Commissioner Good - Edney

Chairman Edney is the Chairman for the coming year.

<u>Vice-Chairman</u> - Chairman Edney nominated Commissioner Baker. Commissioner Baker respectfully declined. Commissioner Baker nominated Commissioner Good. Commissioner Randall nominated William McKay. There were no other nominations. A vote was taken as follows:

Commissioner Good is the Vice-Chairman for the coming year.

#### APPROVAL OF BONDS

David Nicholson informed the Board that each year bonds need to be approved for the following:

Register of Deeds

Sheriff

Tax Collector

Director of Finance.

Mr. Nicholson has reviewed these bonds and they appear to be in order. Copies of the bond certificates were in the agenda packet for review.

Commissioner Good made the motion to approve the bonds as presented. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

#### REVIEW OF MINUTES

Minutes were presented for review of the November 20 meeting and the November 21 meeting. The minutes were discussed and Commissioner Baker wanted a wording change on page 5 of the November 20 minutes. The Clerk was instructed to draft a change and copy the Board members. These revised minutes will appear in the next agenda packet for approval.

The November 21 minutes were approved as presented.

#### DISCUSSION/ADJUSTMENT OF AGENDA

David Nicholson added item "F" under New Business, Request to set Public Hearing (Carriage Park).

Commissioner Baker reminded the Board that they have not named a Chairman for the Travel & Tourism Board. This was added under "C" Nominations as #8.

## PUBLIC INPUT

No one had signed up to speak.

## TAX RELEASES

A total of 83 tax release requests were presented for consideration. These were rolled from the last meeting because the

County Attorney had a legal question regarding Mr. Baird's cover letter. A change has been made in the cover letter and Mr. Baird offered these requests for the Board's approval.

Commissioner Good made the motion that the releases be approved if the paperwork is in order. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

## TAX REFUNDS

A total of seven (7) tax refund requests were presented for consideration. These were rolled from the last meeting for the same reason as the releases. Mr. Baird offered these requests for the Board's approval.

Commissioner McKay made the motion to approve the refunds as recommended if the paperwork is in order. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

## **NOMINATIONS**

- 1. Chairman Edney informed the Board of two (2) vacancies on the Job Training Partnership Act Committee (PIC). There were no nominations at this time so the item was rolled to the next meeting.
- 2. Chairman Edney informed the Board of one (1) vacancy on the Henderson County Travel & Tourism Committee. Commissioner Baker nominated Tune Laphman of Highland Lake Inn to fill the vacancy. There were no other nominations. Commissioner Good made the motion to suspend the rules and appoint Ms. Laphman. All voted in favor and the motion carried.
- 3. Chairman Edney informed the Board of two (2) vacancies on the Industrial Facilities & Pollution Control Board. We have received a response from John Gregory who does not wish to serve another term. There were no nominations at this time so the item was rolled to the next meeting.
- 4. Chairman Edney informed the Board of five (5) vacancies on the Nursing Home/Domiciliary Home Advisory Committee. Commissioner Baker nominated Michael Martin, Liz Barlowe, and Linda Weiman, each to serve an additional term. He also nominated Harrison Tawney. There were no other nominations. Commissioner Good made the motion to suspend the rules and appoint the above four to the Nursing Home/Domiciliary Home Advisory Committee. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

One remaining vacancy will be rolled to the next meeting.

- 5. Chairman Edney informed the Board of one (1) vacancy on the Henderson County Planning Board. Commissioner Baker nominated Donald K. Adams to serve an additional term. Commissioner Baker made the motion to suspend the rules and reappoint Mr. Adams. All voted in favor and the motion carried.
- 6. Chairman Edney informed the Board of three (3) vacancies on the Recreation Committee. Commissioner Baker nominated Beth Carden and Katherine Adams. Chairman Edney nominated Commissioner Baker. Commissioner Good made the motion to suspend the rules and appoint these three to the Recreation Committee. All voted in favor and the motion carried.
- 7. Chairman Edney informed the Board of one (1) vacancy on the Green River Management Board. There was discussion. This item was rolled to the next meeting.
- 8. Chairman Edney informed the Board of the need to name a chairman for the Travel & Tourism Board. Commissioner Baker nominated Fred Niehoff to serve as chairman. Commissioner McKay made the motion to suspend the rules and appoint Mr. Niehoff. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

## SETTING OF PUBLIC HEARING - Public & Private Road Names

Matt Matteson informed the Board that pursuant to Section 302 of the Henderson County Property Address Ordinance, a public hearing needs to be called to name ten (10) private roads and to rename three (3) private roads in Henderson County.

A notice of the hearing will be placed in the <u>Times-News</u>. Once the hearing has been held, the street names may be adopted with whatever changes the Board may wish to make. If another name is suggested, a new public hearing will need to be scheduled.

Mr. Matteson suggested the Public Hearing be set for January 6 at 7:00 p.m.

Commissioner McKay made the motion to set the Public Hearing for the first batch of road names (submitted) for January 6, 1991, here, at 7:00 p.m. as recommended. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

#### DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS VEHICLES

David Nicholson informed the Board of numerous automobiles and trucks that are no longer in service or are used as spare motor pool vehicles. He presented the disposal options and recommended the use of sealed bids.

Mr. Nicholson introduced Frank Aaron, Administrator of Pardee Hospital. They both discussed the possibility of the transfer of an ambulance to Pardee Hospital from EMS. The ambulance would be used by Pardee personnel for transportation of patients on hospital property. If approved, this would eliminate the use of our EMS personnel, who are currently providing this service. Tom Edmundson, Henderson County Emergency Medical Services Director, recommends the transfer.

Commissioner Baker made the motion to transfer the unused ambulance from EMS to Pardee Hospital. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Commissioner Good made the motion to declare the list of vehicles presented as surplus property and to use the method of sealed bids to dispose of the property. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

After some discussion on the issue, Commissioner McKay suggested that staff hold an auction or dispose of these surplus vehicles every six months, so we wouldn't accumulate so many surplus vehicles.

## LATE PENALTY - Room Tax

David Nicholson informed the Board of a request from Skylark Inn for the removal of the late penalty associated with the Henderson County Room Occupancy Tax. A late penalty of \$30.00 was for the September tax collections due to the Finance Department on October 15, 1991. The tax was received in the Finance Department on October 18, three days late. The envelope was postmarked October 16, 1991.

There was much discussion. Commissioner Baker made the motion to reduce the penalty to \$10.00 because of the one day late in posting the envelope and Commissioner Baker requested that staff use the postmark date in the future for assessing the penalty. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

#### UNTIMELY APPLICATION FOR ELDERLY EXEMPTION

Robert Baird, Tax Assessor, presented an "untimely" application for the elderly exemption from Mr. & Mrs. Adger Haynes for the tax year 1991. There was a clerical error on his staff's part. Mr. Baird recommended acceptance.

Commissioner Baker made the motion to accept this application for elderly exemption. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

## REQUEST TO SET PUBLIC HEARING (Carriage Park)

Mr. Matteson informed the Board of a request submitted by First Citizens Bank to amend a Special Use Permit for Carriage Park.

Mr. Matteson stated that at the Planning Board's regular meeting on November 26, 1991, the Board gave favorable recommendation to Mr. Creekman's request to amend Special Use Permit No. 87.2 (Carriage Park Planned Unit Development).

The next step in the process is for the Board of Commissioners to schedule a public hearing and after such hearing to act upon the request.

Commissioner Baker made the motion to set the Public Hearing for January 6, 1991, here, at 7:00 p.m. as recommended. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

These items were discussed at length.

Regarding the discussion of the 1991 appeals, there are four or five appeals that must be heard this year. When the Board of Equalization and Review are not in session the Board of Commissioners sits as the Board of Equalization and Review.

Commissioner McKay made the motion to set December 18 as the date for the Board to sit as the Board of Equalization and Review to hear these appeals, beginning at 3:00 p.m. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Mr. Baird also informed the Board that as a result of GS 105.330 classified motor vehicles, the need to maintain listing abstracts will no longer be necessary beginning January 1, 1993. To prepare our records for personal property items such as mobile homes, the need to establish a mobile home registration program is warranted. Mr. Baird discussed the proposed program at length.

## **EXECUTIVE SESSION**

Commissioner McKay made the motion for the Board to go into Executive Session to discuss matters as allowed under GS 143-318.11. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Commissioner Baker made the motion for the Board to go out of Executive Session. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Being there was no further business, Chairman Edney adjourned the meeting at 9:30 p.m.
