BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS NOVEMBER 19, 1990

The Board of Commissioners met at Mountain Home Fire Department on November 19 at 7:00 p.m. for a Public Hearing.

Present at the meeting: Chairman William T. Drake, Vice-Chairman F. Richard Baker, Commissioner J. Michael Edney, Commissioner Hugh D. Randall, County Administrator Jerry D. Myers, and Clerk to the Board Elizabeth W. Corn. Absent was Commissioner Troy L. Maybin.

Commissioner Baker made the motion for the Board to go into Public Hearing. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Chairman Drake called the meeting to order and stated that the purpose of tonight's meeting is to hear public comment concerning expansion of the Eastern District of the Mountain Home Fire Department.

## Public Comments

The clerk called the names of those who had signed up to speak:

Randy Ward- Mr. Ward questioned whether Mountain Home had deed to the property where they plan to build a substation in the eastern district? He is in opposition if the department does not have deed to the property.

Chairman Drake asked Tommy McCraw, Chief of the Mountain Home Fire Department, to address this question.

Mr. McCraw stated that the department has a lease for 99 years on the Gillespie property.

<u>Carroll McMinn</u>- Mr. McMinn is in favor of expansion of the eastern district.

Steve Brackett- Mr. Brackett is in favor of expansion of the eastern district.

Commissioner Baker made the motion to close the Public Hearing. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Chairman Drake stated that since we do not have a full Board present, it would be inappropriate to take action tonight. It will be added to the agenda for the Commissioners meeting of November



21 and the Board will vote on the proposed district expansion at that time. Should the Board approve the expansion, it will take effect the first of the year, 1991.
