BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
JUNE 12, 1989

The Henderson County Board of Commissioners met at 7:00 P.M. in the Conference Room of the County Office Building for a budget work session.

Those present were: Chairman William T. Drake, Vice-Chairman F. Richard Baker, Commissioner Hugh D. Randall, Commissioner Troy L. Maybin, Commissioner J. Michael Edney, County Administrator Jerry D. Myers, Finance Director David Nicholson, and Clerk to the Board Elizabeth W. Corn.

Chairman Drake called the meeting to order, then Mr. Nicholson proceeded to review the budget with the Board.

Revenues were the first thing to be reviewed: Tax Land Sales, Ad Valorem Taxes, Intangibles Taxes, Local Option Sales Taxes, ADC Revenues, Beer & Wine Licenses, Franchise Fees, Indirect charges and costs, Payment in lieu of taxes, Register of Deeds Revenue, Various Refunds, Court Facilities Fees, Board of Elections Revenues, Sheriff Dept. Revenues, Jail Revenues, Telephone Reimbursements, State Share for Civil Preparedness, Inspections Dept. Revenues, Ambulance Revenues, Forestry Service Payments, Grants, Refunds, D.S.S. Revenues, Library Revenues, Recreation Dept. Revenues, Transfers from other funds, Lease-Purchase Transfers, Interest Earned, Rents and Concessions, Sale of County Properties, Miscellaneous Revenues, Refunds to County, Fire Training Ground, Fund Balance Appropriated.

Mr. Nicholson then reviewed the following departmental budgets with the Board: Governing Body, Administration, Finance Department, Tax Assessor, Tax Collector, County Attorney, Board of Elections, Register of Deeds, Data Processing, Garage and Grounds, and Public Buildings.

The Board will continue its budget work sessions next Monday night, June 19, 1989 at 7:00 P.M. in the Conference Room of the County Office Building. No action was taken on the budget.

Commissioner Baker made a motion to go into Executive Session for the discussion of personnel matters. The motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Maybin made a motion to go out of Executive Session. The motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
