Henderson County Commissioners July 18, 2018 Meeting Public Statement

Good morning, my name is Harold Hellickson. My purpose this morning is to inform and educate. I am not asking the Commission to consider anything at all. That will come later.

I am part of a small group of concerned citizens forming a local county chapter of a national organization, REPRESENT US. REPRESENT US, is the push organization behind THE AMERICAN ANTI-CORRUPTION ACT. This proposed legislation was developed by collaborative leaders from both sides of the political spectrum. I have characterized it as the only thing these 20 plus people could agree on; see my earlier letter to the editor attached.

THE AMERICAN ANTI-CORRUPTION ACT deals with campaign financing and transparency, lobbying, the revolving door and other matters of governance important to voters in a democracy; see a one page summary attached.

To date, modifications to THE AMERICAN ANTI-CORRUPTION ACT appropriate to state and local elected governances have been approved through voter referendum. In non-Home Rule states, in Dillon states such as our own, numerous local elected bodies have passed resolutions of support. At some future date, we will be asking each elected governance body in our county to pass a resolution, currently under development, supporting improved governance based on this Act. Examples of such resolutions throughout the country as well as NC abound.

Thank you the opportunity of exposing you to this important matter. Seven copies of this talk and the referenced attachments are hereby provided. We will have more to say at some later date.
