#### CALL TO ORDER/WELCOME

## Cane Creek Water and Sewer District - Minutes of February 21, 2018

1) February 21, 2018

Commissioner Lapsley made the motion to approve the Cane Creek Water & Sewer District minutes of February 21, 2018. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

# **Award Construction Contract - Mud Creek Interceptor Project Construction Contract:**

Marcus Jones stated as directed in the District's approved budget, Mud Creek Interceptor Project was bid on June 19, 2018. As recommended by WGLA Engineering on the attached letter, Buchanan and Sons, Incorporated is presented to the Board for award of the construction contract. The proposed contract is for \$3,056,970.00.

The project falls within the statutory requirements for a formal bid process and therefore, the Engineer has conducted the bidding accordingly. Additionally, the project was advertised in the local newspaper and posted on the County website.

The proposed budget is as follows:

This project was approved in the FY2019 budget and financed with the District's fund balance and a construction loan.

It was the Board's understanding that staff would request that easements requests would include allowing the county to build a greenway along the easement. Staff was requested to go back to the easement requests and report back to the Board at the next meeting.

Commissioner Lapsley made the motion that the Board of Directors award the construction contract for the Mud Creek Interceptor Project to Buchanan and Sons, Incorporated for \$3,056,970, approve the proposed project budget and authorize the County Engineer to execute the required documents with contingency that all easements be obtained without open cost before signing the contract. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Commissioner Edney made the motion to adjourn as the Cane Creek Water & Sewer District Board and reconvene as the Board of Commissioners. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Dear Mr. Jones:

As you know, bids were received for the Mud Creek Interceptor project on June 19, 2018. While we had seven contractors attend a prebid meeting, only three contractors submitting bids. The bids ranged from a low of \$3,410,567.00 submitted by Buchanan and Sons to a high of \$6,678,315.00 submitted by Dillard Excavating. Due to the range of pricing in the bids, we have spoken with Buchanan and Sons several times confirming they are comfortable with the bid they submitted. They have confirmed they are comfortable with their bid as submitted.

In addition to the base bid, two alternate bids were submitted. The first alternate was for installing a gravity service under US 25 that would eliminate two existing force main lines. The second alterative was for installing PVC piping instead of ductile iron piping. Based on conversations with staff, we would recommend accepting both alternate bids. This would bring the recommended award to \$3,056,970.00 to Buchanan and Sons, Inc.

In addition to the construction costs, we would recommend that the County budget 10% of the construction cost or \$305,700 in a contingency fund. Also, there will be some upgrades necessary to the Mud Creek pump station to accommodate additional flows and to provide additional capacity. This will be accomplished outside of the Buchanan contract. Finally, there will be some cost associated with securing of the final easements for the project. We would recommend a budget of \$75,000. In summary the construction budget would be:
