

PROPOSAL

Change the Scope of Work for TIP R-2588B to terminate at the intersection of NC191 and Rugby Middle School rather than at Mountain Road. This would maintain the current configuration (2-lanes improved by W-5506 Safety Project) in the eliminated segment.

Benefits:

- Improved lane reduction visibility to motorists
- Eliminated cost due to reduced project corridor length
- Eliminated cost due to avoiding utility relocation (incl. 2347 ft sewer line)
- Eliminated cost due to additional ROW not needed
- Eliminated impact on all southern private property owners
