SUMMARY OF REQUEST:

Staff has negotiated the County's hauling and disposal contract, and requests the Board approve the attached proposal from Republic Services to extend their Hauling and Disposal contract with the County Solid Waste Department. Details on the proposal and its review can be found on the attached staff presentation.

AMENDMENT TO TRANSPORTATION AND DISPOSAL AGREEMENT

This Amendment to Solid Waste Transportation and Disposal Agreement (this "Amendment") is entered into as of November _____, 2019 ("Effective Date"), between the County of Henderson, North Carolina, (the "County"), and Republic Services of Kentucky, LLC d/b/a Republic Services of Raleigh ("Contractor").

Recitals

- A. The parties entered into that certain Transportation and Disposal Agreement dated July 1, 2015, (the "Agreement"), pursuant to which Contractor agreed to provide solid waste hauling and disposal services to the County.
- B. The parties desire to enter into this Amendment to extend the term and modify certain terms as identified below.

Agreement

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which the parties acknowledge, the parties agree to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. <u>Term.</u> The Term of the Agreement, identified in Section 2, is extended for an additional ten-year term, commencing on July 1, 2020 and ending on June 30, 2030.
 - 2. <u>Compensation.</u> Section 3 is modified as follows:
- (a) Effective as of July 1, 2020, the County shall pay Republic a Disposal Fee of \$38.50 per ton, as adjusted pursuant to Section 3.1. The rate escalator in Section 3.1 will not apply until July 1, 2022.
 - (b) The CPI cap in Section 3.1 is changed to 4%.
 - (c) Section 3.3 is modified to change the Minimum Average to 22 tons.
- 3. <u>Insurance</u>. Section 9, Insurance, is modified as follows: The certificates shall not contain any express obligations but rather shall include a notice of cancellation endorsement that shall provide the County with thirty (30) days' notice of any cancellation of the required policies, other than workers' compensation.
- 4. <u>Capitalized Terms</u>. Capitalized terms used but not otherwise defined in this Amendment shall have the meanings assigned to them in the Agreement.
- 5. <u>Continuing Effect</u>. Except as expressly modified or amended by this Amendment, all terms and provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect. In the case of a conflict in meaning between the Agreement and this Amendment, this Amendment shall prevail.
- 6. <u>Counterparts</u>. This Amendment may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which combined shall constitute one and the

same instrument. Facsimile and/or electronic copies of the parties' signatures shall be valid and treated the same as original signatures.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have entered into this Amendment to be effective as of the Effective Date.

Contract History

- 1997: County contracted with Waste Management to transport waste to their Palmetto Landfill in Spartanburg, SC
- 2010: With close of Palmetto Landfill, County contracted with Republic Services to transport waste to their Upstate Landfill in Union County, SC
- 2015: County continues to contract with Republic Services
- 2020: Proposal from Republic to extend 2015 contract

- \$10 / ton increase over 20 years
- Average annual increase of 1.61%
- About \$20 / ton over the contract fee to run the Stoney Mountain Facility:
 - Convenience Center
 - Closed Landfills
 - Transfer Station
 - Waste Diversion



Details of Proposal

- The fee is reduced from \$40.02 to \$38.50 per ton for transportation and disposal.
- The fee is held at \$38.50 with no annual inflation adjustment until July 1, 2022.
- The maximum annual inflation rate (CPI) is reduced from 5% to 4% CPI = 90% of the Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers (Water, Sewer and Trash Collection) US City Average, as published by United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Statistics).
- The term of the extension is for 10 years: July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2030.

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Details of Proposal, continued

Proposals includes a change of the trucking subcontractor to Hilco Transport.

- Hilco is a very reputable trucking company based on staff and Republic's research.
- Republic is switching other operations to Hilco as well.
- Hilco is \$7.50 per ton more expensive than current trucking subcontractor.



Staff Analysis

- Republic proposal cost can be verified based on the bid results in 2015 and the lack of changes in the Solid Waste disposal industry in our service area.
- Proposal reduces fee by \$1.52 / ton and increase contract value by \$7.50. This is a strong proposal compared to the fee increases paid since 1997.
- Trucking cost increase can also be independently verified the based on previous bids received from Hilco and Republic in 2015, the inflation in the trucking industry, and with Hilco increased quality of service (safety and dependability)

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Staff Analysis, continued

Impact on the Solid Waste enterprise fund (self-supporting) is positive.

- The \$1.52 / ton reduction translates to an annual expense reduction of \$182,400 in FY2021.
- This reduction continues in FY2022.
- From FY2023 through FY2030, the fee increases annually by a published index as during the 2010 and 2015 contracts.
- With the fee less than \$40 / ton it is reasonable to forecast that our current tipping of \$60 / ton implemented in 2016 can remain through FY2023 or beyond.
- Maintaining a low tipping fee is critical to Solid Waste remaining self-sufficient.

- Used 2.00% increase with 1.61% the historical increase.
