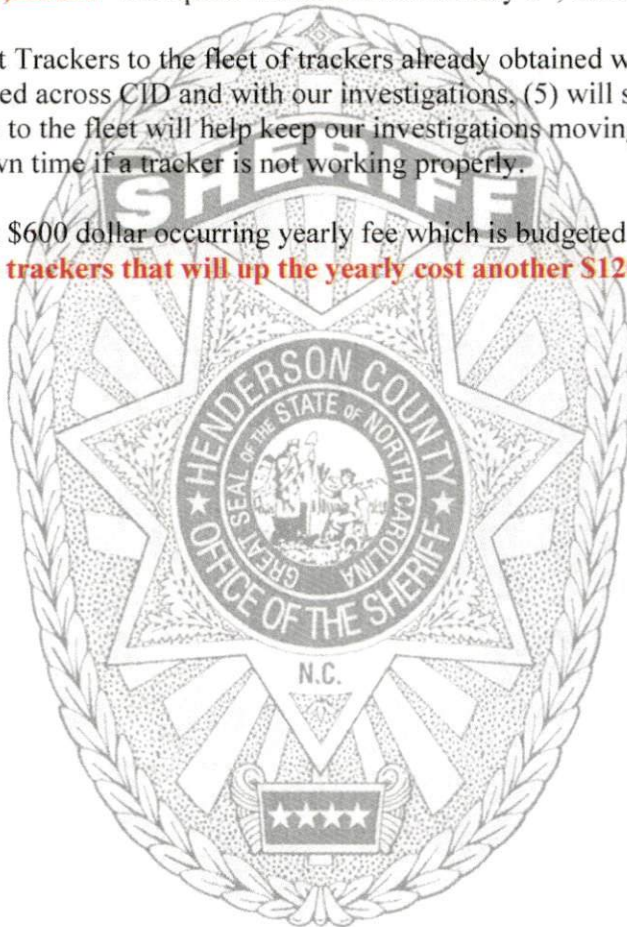

Request for (2) Covert Stealth Tracking Devices along with the (1 year) of 5 second updates and Annual Subscription to Access the Covert Track Mapping product. This Quote includes shipping and handling and Tax. **The quote total is \$3,553.84.** This quote was estimated on July 5th, 2022. Quote is attached.

By adding two more Covert Trackers to the fleet of trackers already obtained will up the tracker Qty to (7) total. These trackers are used across CID and with our investigations, (5) will sometimes leave us short on trackers. Adding two more to the fleet will help keep our investigations moving smoothly and allows for proper deployment and down time if a tracker is not working properly.

With each tracker there is a \$600 dollar occurring yearly fee which is budgeted for the (5) current trackers now. **By adding two more trackers that will up the yearly cost another \$1200.00 for yearly budget.**

This request is for (3) Canon CR-NR300 4K NDI PTZ Cameras. These will be used to create mobile camera capability to gain intel for investigations with real-time information. These cameras can be used for everyday investigations in the county that we feel are a hot target for criminal theft, drug investigation that can eventually lead to large criminal enterprise operations. These cameras also give detectives the capability to build certain hides around the cameras to make them fit into the surroundings involving the target locations. It can also assist the residents of Henderson County to be proactive in our work by using mobile cameras to keep real time information 24/7. Each of these cameras require a Cradle point for the cameras to operate correctly and that justification has been listed above. Both quotes will be also attached with cost. There are no yearly fees associated with these cameras. **The current quote for these camera's is \$8,643.55.** This includes free shipping and tax. This quote was estimated on July 6th, 2022. Quote is attached.

Cradle Points

This quote is for Concise Network for Cradle Points that will assist in running the Canon CR-N300 PTZ cameras that will be used for covert operations and allow for cameras to be mobile for investigation purposes. These will be using the FirstNet platform and are 5G compatible. We currently have 2 cradle points at this time, and we are looking to expand cradle points so that we can have more camera systems available and use across CID in a whole. **The current quote for these three cradle points is \$4,790.74.** This quote was estimated on May 19th, 2022.

There are no yearly fees associated with these cradle points.

Cutting Edge Power X 2

Battery boxes to be used in conjunction with PTZ cameras and Cradle point routers for modular self-sustained cover systems. Current covert camera system requires external power source. These battery boxes would allow our covert cameras to be used in rural locations where external power is not an option. Our covert camera system would become completely self-sustained. **Total for one unit is \$3149.28. Total for two units which is recommended is \$6,298.56.**

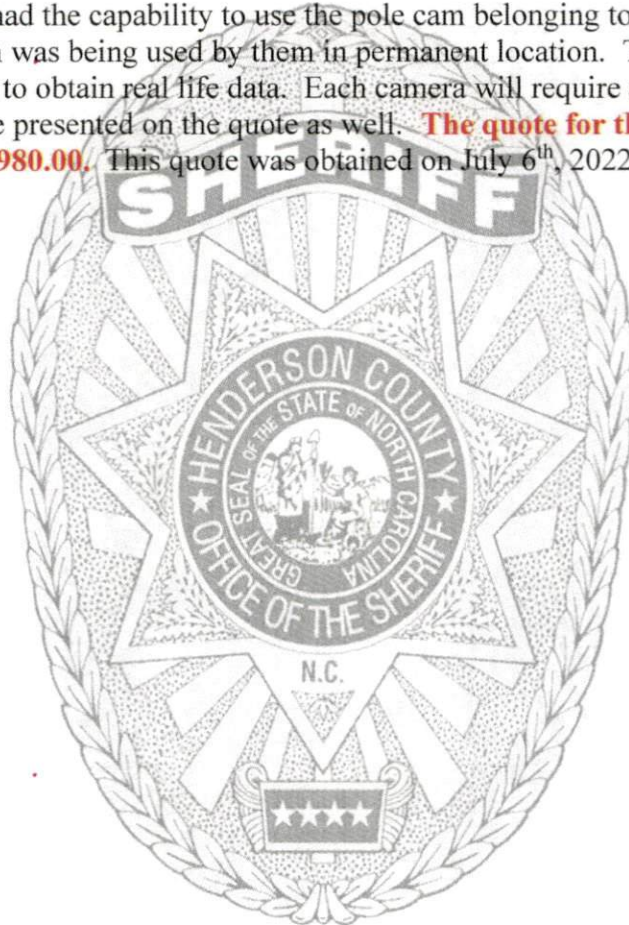

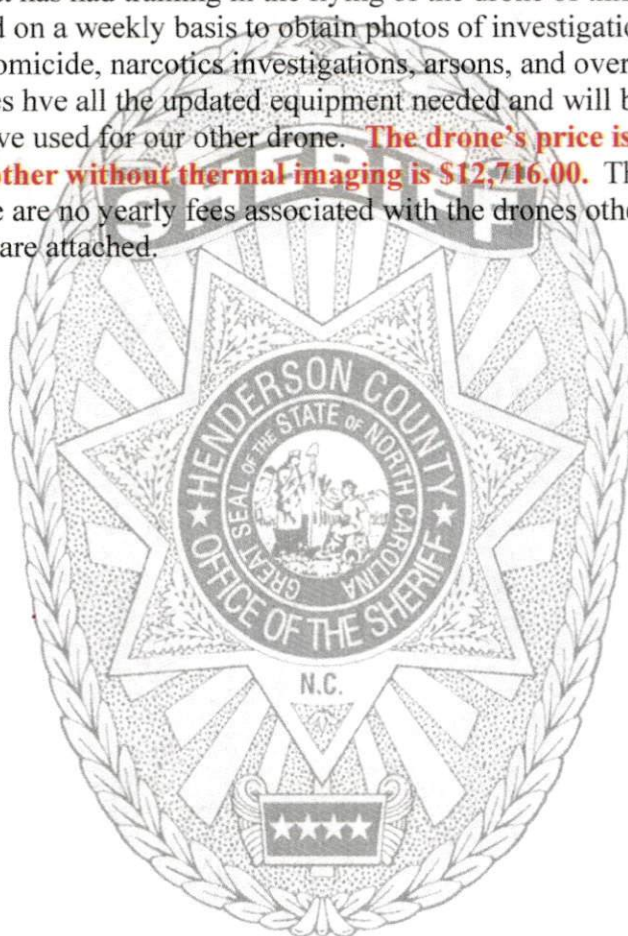

Leica 360 Crime Scene Mapping

Proper documentation and processing of Crime Scenes is a crucial factor in the investigative process, as well as the successful prosecution of offenders through every step of the judicial process. Several Henderson County Sheriff's Office Investigators have attended the National Forensic Academy, a 10-week program through the University of Tennessee which is "designed to meet the needs of law enforcement agencies in evidence identification, collection, and preservation" (leic.tennessee.edu). As a part of this training, Investigators learn about, and practice using tools that assist in more accurately and efficiently documenting and processing crime scenes, including specifically 3D Crime Scene Scanners. These 3D scanners can be utilized to process crime scenes while simultaneously reducing personnel hours and increasing accuracy. Recently, 3 detectives from the Major Crimes Unit responded to an arson scene where approximately 11 vehicles and one building were burned. These Detectives were on-scene for over 8 hours each, with a vast majority of those hours being dedicated to measuring and mapping out the location of evidence and vehicles. In total, over 24 personnel hours

were spent properly documenting the scene. Conversely, had these investigators had access to the Leica RTC 360 3D Crime Scene scanner, the same process would have taken less than approximately 1 hour, including set up and break down of the unit, resulting in an approximate 87% reduction in personnel hours dedicated to the same task. This example is only one crime scene, whereas the Major Crimes Unit to date has responded to: 1 Homicide, 59 Aggravated Assaults, 13 Arsons, and over 100 Death Investigations. An 87% increase in the amount of time spent processing each of these scenes would allow Investigators to devote more time to the actual investigation, which is often a time sensitive matter.

In addition to crime scene mapping, the Leica RTC 360 3D scanner may be utilized for threat assessment pre planning and preparation in public buildings, such as schools and government buildings/offices and churches. The Leica RTC 360 3D scanner can be used to scan the interior and exterior of buildings and build a 3D computer model which is an accurate representation of the internal and external building layout. This would allow emergency services personnel to have the ability to "view" the layout of a building electronically and identify ingress, and egress points as well as areas of special concern. Additionally, the Henderson County Sheriff's Office would become an asset to other law enforcement and emergency services agencies in the Western North Carolina region, as there are currently no comparable scanners in the area. This would allow the opportunity for Henderson County to be reimbursed for the use of the scanner, including personnel hours and maintenance cost/fee per utilization, while contributing to the efficiency of crime scene processing and threat assessment to the Western North Carolina region.

The Leica RTC 360 scanner would assist with the "CSI" effect in court. Currently, it is not uncommon to hear an Assistant District Attorney explain to a jury during criminal trials that they will not be able to view or watch 3D computer models of crime scenes as they may expect after watching TV shows such as "CSI." The Leica RTC 3D scanner, and the computer models it is capable of building, would

give jurors what they expect to see in modern legal proceedings and trials: digital 3D crime scene maps and models.

The Leica RTC 360 unit was specifically chosen due to the operational range of the unit when compared to the average weather and temperature fluctuations of the Western North Carolina region. The Leica RTC 360 is designed to operate in the rain, and has an operational temperature range of below 0 degrees F to 115 degrees F. Other units do not offer these capabilities and therefore would not be able to be used during certain portions of the year or during inclement weather.

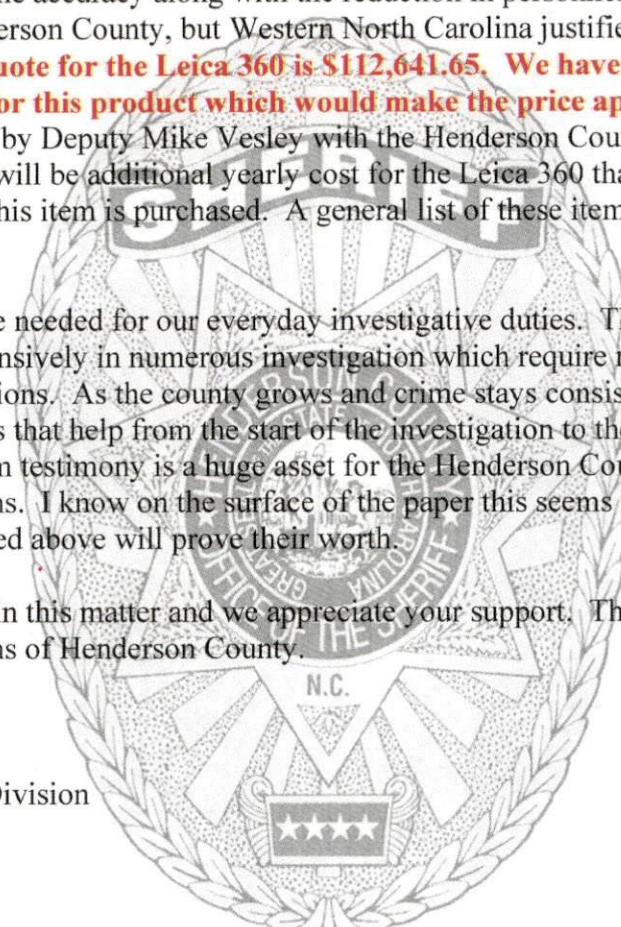
The increase in crime scene accuracy along with the reduction in personnel hours and the ability to be an asset to not only Henderson County, but Western North Carolina justifies the purchase of the Leica RTC 360 scanner. **The quote for the Leica 360 is \$112,641.65. We have received a \$24,500.00 grant that can be used for this product which would make the price approximately \$88,141.65.**

The grant was completed by Deputy Mike Vesley with the Henderson County Sheriffs Office. The quote is attached. There will be additional yearly cost for the Leica 360 that will have to be budgeted into the yearly budget if this item is purchased. A general list of these items is listed with the quote on an additional sheet.

The above listed items are needed for our everyday investigative duties. The Criminal Investigation Division has worked extensively in numerous investigation which require more advance technical aspects to their investigations. As the county grows and crime stays consistent throughout, being able to provide up to date tools that help from the start of the investigation to the successful prosecution from charges to courtroom testimony is a huge asset for the Henderson County Sheriff's Office and the Henderson County citizens. I know on the surface of the paper this seems to be a lot of money, but in a short time the items listed above will prove their worth.

The Henderson County Sheriff's Office SWAT Team is tasked with several high risk operational functions including but not limited to executing search warrants, arrest warrants, barricaded subjects, and rescue operations. These type of events are extremely dangerous to everyone involved. One of the tactics utilized in the safe resolution of these high risk operations is deconstruction of the structure and the administration of chemical munitions, smoke, and distraction devices. One of the tools at the disposal of the SWAT Team is a Lenco Bearcat. The Bearcat is currently equipped with a needle that can penetrate a structure and administer chemical munitions or smoke. However, the limitation to the needle is that it can only deploy one canister/munition at a time and is not capable of deploying distraction devices. Whenever the needle is utilized, the Bearcat has to be driven to a place of cover and concealment where the team can install the needle onto the Bearcat, load the desired munition, and then head back to the target location. This has to be done each time a new munition needs to be deployed into the structure with the use of the needle and causes the Bearcat to have to leave the target structure for a period long enough to reload the needle which then requires SWAT Operators and other officers to maintain cover of the structure without an effective piece of armor like the Bearcat. Additionally, in past callouts the wiring and hydraulic system utilized to deploy the munitions through the needle have been damaged during deployments into structures because of the lack of protection afforded to these components. The needle is also incapable of deploying distraction devices which means that if the SWAT Team wished to deploy a distraction device they would have to do so outside of the cover of the Bearcat with either a hand deployment or with the use of a bang pole. For the above reasons I am requesting that we purchase the J&N Tactical DRACO gas delivery system. The DRACO is the first reliable effective means of safely deploying effective chemical munitions into structures since events in the early 1990s exposed the dangers of deploying gas canisters inside of structures. The days of breaking cover to fire ineffective 40mm launchable chemical munitions are in the past as long as you can access the structure with an armored vehicle and the DRACO. SWAT Teams that utilize the DRACO gas delivery system have had successful first and second story deployments with the DRACO to the point of product coming out of both the soffit and ridge vents. The DRACO gas delivery system is a life saving piece of technology that can be put into situations where, in times past, officers had to be deployed instead. The DRACO gas delivery system is a multi-tool designed specifically for the safe delivery of chemical munitions and distraction devices into a hostile environment, including hardened structures and/or vehicles.
