- WHEREAS,** the residents of Henderson County have great respect, admiration, and the utmost gratitude for all the men and women who have selflessly served our country and this community in the Armed Forces; and
- WHEREAS,** the contributions and sacrifices of the men and women who served in the Armed Forces have been vital in maintaining the freedoms and way of life enjoyed by our citizens; and
- WHEREAS,** Henderson County seeks to honor these individuals who have paid the high price for freedom by placing themselves in harm's way for the good of all; and
- WHEREAS,** Approximately 200,000 service members transition to civilian communities annually; and

- WHEREAS,** the Henderson County appreciates the sacrifices of our United State Military Personnel and believes specific recognition should be granted;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Henderson County Board of Commissioners and the citizens of Henderson County recognize the immeasurable value and valiant contributions made by our veterans during war time and peace time. The Henderson County Historic Courthouse will be illuminated in green light from November 7<sup>th</sup> through November 13<sup>th</sup> in support of all our veterans. We encourage the businesses and residents of Henderson County to join us by displaying their own green lights.
