PROCLAMATION Designating June as Elder Abuse Awareness Month

- **WHEREAS,** in 2006, the International Network for the Prevention of Elder Abuse, in support of the United Nations International Plan of Action, proclaimed a day to recognize the significance of elder abuse as a public health and human rights issue; and
- WHEREAS, Henderson County's vulnerable and elder adults deserve to live safely with dignity; and
- **WHEREAS,** vulnerable and elder adults of all socio-economic, racial and ethnic backgrounds may be targets of abuse, neglect or exploitation which occurs in families, long term care facilities and communities; and
- WHEREAS, Henderson County Adult Protective Services received 579 reports in 2022 with 339 screened in for evaluation; and
- WHEREAS, we know that elder abuse and mistreatment are underreported according to a study by the World Health Organization that found only 1 in 24 cases of elder abuse is reported; and
- WHEREAS, recognizing that it is up to all of us, to ensure that proper social structures exist so people can retain community and societal connections, reducing the likelihood of abuse; and
- **WHEREAS,** protecting Henderson County's vulnerable and elder adults is a community responsibility and it is imperative that communities work together to help reduce and prevent abuse, neglect and exploitation; and
- WHEREAS, all residents should watch for signs of abuse such as physical trauma, withdrawal, depression, anxiety, fear of family members, friends or caregivers and report suspected abuse or exploitation to the Department of Social Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Henderson County Board of Commissioners does hereby declare June as Elder Abuse Awareness Month in Henderson County, and encourages the community to work together to help reduce and prevent abuse, neglect and exploitation of our elders.
