Debris Updates

Debris Collection

- ▶ Debris removal operations continue under the NCEM SMART Agreement.
- ▶ Right of Way (ROW) operations are at the “punch-list” point completing target areas.
- ▶ HCEM and NCSMART continue to collaborate on open PPDR projects.
- ▶ Approximately 1,157 waterway debris sites have been identified by County staff and are awaiting FEMA approval.
