Minutes of Board Meeting
August 22, 2023

The Board of Elections met August 22, 2023, at 5:00 PM at the Henderson County Board of Elections office at 75 E. Central Street. Members present were Clay Eddleman, Chair, Debbie Dante, Secretary, Linda Rebuck, William Cutler, and Sharon Pearson, Members, and Summer Heatherly, Director. Henderson County Register of Deeds, Lee King, guest.

Pledge

Minutes: Minutes were approved for 7/28/23.

Agenda: Linda moved to approve the agenda. Sharon 2nd. Passed unanimously.

Old Business: None.

New Business: Oath of New Board Member. William Cutler was reappointed to the Board by the SBOE and Henderson County Register of Deeds, Lee King, was present to administer the Oath to him.

Introduction of Chair. Clay Eddleman, MD (see attached bio).

Announcement of Director. Addendum to Election Director's Duties will be reviewed and sent to Human Resources

Report on ES&S Updates. Aaron spoke to ES&S at the recent state conference. They are offering new software (6.3.0) and new hardware that has been approved by the SBOE. We are on version 5.2.4, purchased in 2019. Aaron doesn't see the need to invest 15K in an upgrade at this time as the equipment is only 5 years old. We had the IVOS 10-15 years before they were replaced.

Appointment of Chief Judges/Judges. 46 brand new volunteer poll workers were nominated with a total of 156 Chief Judges/Judges appointed (see attached). Appointees were listed by the precinct they live in and were appointed to serve in their home precinct per NCGS §163-41. Linda moved to accept the nominated names from the 2 parties, as listed. Sharon 2nd. Passed unanimously.

Polling Locations. Director will schedule BOE member visits to our 35 polling locations. She will provide voter data and maps. They will take photos of all the precincts and plan how the rooms are set up. Bill moved the Board visit/survey all polling locations for informational purposes. Linda 2nd. Passed unanimously.

Thank You Letters to Applicants. Sharon moved to send thank you letters to the applicants for the Director's job. Linda 2nd. Passed unanimously. The Board signed 5 letters.

EBANC (Elections Board Association of NC). Discussion showed this in not an active club and the Board will not approve funds to join.

Absentee Ballot – Reasonable Impediment. Director asked the Board do they want staff to accept/approve Photo ID Exception Forms mailed in with Absentee Ballots? Unanimous vote for the Board to view the Photo ID Exception Forms mailed in with Absentee Ballots. Director asked does the Board want to view all Forms or just the ones that checked box # 4. Other? Absentee Ballots will be sent Jan 1 for the March 5 Primary. Board will approve the One-Stop Plan in October and this question will be tabled until then.

Emergency Plan. Director supplied copies of the 2021 BOE Emergency Plan for the Board to review and discuss at the next meeting.

Linda moved to go into Closed Session per NCGS§ 143-318.11(a)(6) to discuss personnel matters: the Director's bonus time hours. Sharon 2nd. Passed unanimously.

Board moved into closed session at 6:01 PM.
Returned into open session at 7:10 PM.

Director's Comments: The Photo ID machine is working great. Aaron has a ticket into SBOE regarding taking it off site. They recommend that the Party Chairs get a portable copier to help absentee voters copy their ID. We need to work on Education of Photo ID. Possibly get new banners with one-stop dates and "Photo ID Required".

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:28 PM.



Dr. Eddleman is a retired Physician, whose Specialty was Psychiatry. He was in the US Navy for six years reaching the rank of Commander. He worked at the VA Medical Center in Atlanta, including being on the faculty at Emory University's School of Medicine, for twenty years and was named Professor Emeritus when he retired in 2000. After moving to Henderson County, he continued to work with veterans at the VA Medical Center in Asheville as a consultant on an as needed basis during times of staffing shortages. Ten years ago, he became involved in local politics and has served as Chair of the Henderson County Democratic Party, First Vice-Chair of the 11th Congressional District Democratic Party, and several terms on the State Executive Committee of the North Carolina Democratic Party.
