CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 3:30

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

- 2. Etowah/Horseshoe Plan

Alexis Baker gave a summary on Etowah-Horseshoe community's plan. The Commissioners had previously held a workshop on the plan, planning board gave recommendations, and the plan had unanimous support among the board. Commissioners will set a public hearing date at their Monday April 6th meeting to approve the plan. Both Etowah and Horseshoe were equally represented. Key recommendations were reviewed, and the issues the community faces such as sewer plants, package plants, and golf course water purity, followed by Q&A.

Jeff Jennings voiced his satisfaction of the Etowah-Horseshoe plan – made a motion to adopt all recommendations, Rich De Simone seconded.

Bob Anderson, President of Etowah's Reach Development, spoke about his concern of the lack of agricultural preservation. Alexis addressed his concern and Anthony Starr elaborated on the role of the county in regulating and enforcing agricultural preservation.

Angela Fernandini voiced her concern of the plan's stance on designating rail lines as greenways when there is possibility of future use for mass transit. Angela also wanted to note the Lion's Club recycling in

Etowah.

A vote was taken to adopt all recommendations of the Etowah-Horseshoe Plan, and it passed

unanimously. Dave Lowles assigned the committee to work on more modifications to the

recommendations.
