As healthcare providers and educators, it is our responsibility to promote health and wellness in students, patients, and communities. We support recommendations for overall cardiovascular health established by the American Heart Association that states people should participate in at least 30 minutes of moderate-intensity aerobic activity 5 days per week, or at least 25 minutes of vigorous aerobic activity 3 days per week; or a combination of the two. Through the construction of 70 miles of interconnected greenways, as proposed in the Henderson County Greenway Master Plan, more residents would be able to meet these recommendations by partaking in activities such as walking, running, and biking.
