

- Resources to help pay for medications, medical equipment and supplies, adaptive devices, visits to the doctor, utilities or food;
- ♦ How to find health care and dental providers;
- How and where to apply for disability income for a child;
- How to find services when relocating to, and within, North Carolina;
- Information about health care transitions for children and youth with special health care needs.


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


