Strive Not To Drive Becomes Simply Strive; Henderson County Strives To Learn New Ways Of Transportation

Strive Not To Drive has been a presence in Asheville and across the greater region since 1991, returning every May with the message that we can live happier and healthier when we move through our area without being heavily reliant on cars. As the campaign expands across Western North Carolina, it has become clear that there's more to gain by asking neighbors what they want to strive toward instead of what to strive against. Thus the shortened, more positive moniker, STRIVE.

Henderson County looks forward to its participation each May in the outreach that Strive promotes. This May promises to be an exciting one. To kick off the schedule of events in Henderson County, Strive Beyond Summit will be held at Sierra Nevada Brewing in Mills River on Friday, May 18 from 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. The summit features two moderated panels of local and national experts in transportation and focuses on transportation options that have worked in similar regions and can work for Western North Carolina.

Public questions and a meet-and-greet will follow the panels. The summit is hosted by Sierra Nevada Brewing Company and cosponsored by AARP, Explore Asheville, Land of Sky Regional Council, Biltmore Farms Hotels, Mountain True, and Asheville on Bikes.
