Hendersonville High and Ninth Avenue School Annuals Now Available Online

HC-2019-33 Hendersonville, NC – September 30, 2019

Annuals from Hendersonville High School and the Ninth Avenue School are now available online at the Digital Heritage Center (www.digitalnc.org) thanks to Henderson County Public Library. Beginning last year, Reference Librarian Mark Burdette worked with partners at the Henderson County Genealogical and Historical Society and the Ninth Avenue Alumni group to assemble a large run of annuals from each school and loan them to the Digital Heritage Center located at UNC-Chapel Hill for digitization. This project is part of an ongoing program by the Digital Heritage Center to preserve North Carolina history. The only cost to the library was for shipping the annuals to Chapel Hill.

With the involvement of all the participants Ninth Avenue School annuals from 1950-1965 were digitized along with Hendersonville High School annuals from 1916, 1948-1953, 1956-1957, and 1959-1963 making valuable historical and genealogical resources available to the public for free.

"I am pleased with the outcome of this project and with the willingness of our community partners to lend their print resources," says Burdette, "we could not have made these books available to a wider audience without them and the Digital Heritage Center."
