1. A brief description of the firm and its program of services with emphasis on the firm's history and resource capability to perform the required services.
2. The project team and the individual qualifications of the members of the team.



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3. A list of recent related project experience. The project experience of the project team and/or related experience within Henderson County is particularly important. In addition, each project listed needs to have past client contact information.
4. Outline the proposed services for soils, foundations, concrete, and steel testing, and any other services necessary and/or required to complete the work.
5. Any other information that might be relevant to the selection process.
6. Additional references.

The owner may or may not interview potential candidates to assist in the selection process. The selected firm will be qualified and selected based on the information contained in their respective submitted qualification packages.
