Henderson County Public Library Phase II Operations HC-2019-23 Hendersonville, NC – May 29, 2020

Beginning Monday, June 1, 2020, the Henderson County Public Library will add limited services to select locations while keeping measures in place to protect the health of staff and patrons.

The following services will be available at the **Main, Edneyville, Etowah, and Fletcher Libraries** from 10 a.m.-4 p.m. Monday-Friday and 10 a.m.-2 p.m. Saturday. The Mills River and Green River Libraries will remain closed until further notice.

- **Curbside pickup:** Place items on hold through the online catalog or by calling your preferred library location. Once you are notified your items are available you may stop by your selected pick up library and your items will be delivered to your vehicle.
- **Computer Access:** Internet computers and printing services will be available for a 1 hour use by appointment only. Access will be available for school or job related use, including filing for unemployment, searching for work, creating a resume, and filing taxes. Please call your preferred location to make an appointment.
