### **Question And Answer**

- Q: What is the make/model and size of the projection screen that is in the Commissioner's Meeting room?
- A: The screen is a Da-Lite model AS20-08, part #84762 on a 170.5" roller, it was installed in 2008. Please include the replacement of the projection screen in your proposal.

#### Q: Does the current systems touchscreen(s) control the projection screen?

A: There are no current touchscreens in the room so the control for the screen is a manual switch (as are the blinds). It shall have the ability to control the screen and blinds from the touch screen controllers.

#### Q: How is the current projector mounted in the Commissioner's room?

- A: The current projector (NEC Model NP-PA550W) it is not mounted.
- Q: Does the Commissioner's Meeting Room need a large display in addition to the touch displays at each seat?
- A: There is currently a 55" display in front of the dais, the individual touch displays are intended to replace that display.
- Q: How is the audio coverage in the current Commissioners meeting room? Are there any issues with capturing participants?
- A: Audio coverage is adequate. However, issues occur when members of the public or others are presenting from the podium and are not speaking directly into the microphone.
