Subject: Addendum 1: ITB-Finance Department Restroom Renovation

Date: January 12, 2024

This addendum forms a part of and modifies the bidding requirements, contract forms, contract conditions, and/or the specifications for the Invitation to Bid: Finance Department Restroom Renovation. Bidder shall acknowledge receipt of the Addendum by signature and date below. The signed addendum shall be submitted as a part of your proposal. Failure to do so may subject the Bidder to **disqualification**.

The following clarifications, modifications, and/or additions are to be made to the scope of work:

Q1: Are recessed mirror / soap dispenser combination units being reused?

A1: No, all recessed mirrors, soap dispensers, and trash receptacles are to be removed, holes patched and tiled over or drywalled over above tile level.

Q2: Will section of sheetrock and mirror remain in restroom at end of hallway?

A2: No, drywall and mirror will be removed in order to tile around entire perimeter of restroom. Mirror is to be saved for later use.

Q3: Will tile be installed to the ceiling?

A3: No, tile will be installed on walls to same height as existing tile and transitioned using a Schluter, L angle edge trim.

Q4: How should tiled be transitioned at doorways?

A4: There is a significant height difference in the lobby doorways and should be ground down to a workable slope and transitioned with a standard Hollywood bevel cultured marble threshold.

Q5: Are grab bars to be included in the bid?

A5: No, Existing grab bars may be reused or Facility Services will provide new grab bars to be installed by awarded contractor if old ones are deemed to not be reused.

Q6: bid?	Do Soap dispensers, paper towel, and toilet paper dispensers need to be included in the
A6:	No, Facility Services will provide and install all paper and soap dispensers after completion.
A7:	Does touch up painting need to be included in the bid? No, Facility Services will touch up paint after completion, but drywall surfaces need to be finished, sanded, and prepped for painting.
