Howard was a Technical Sergeant in the U.S. Army in the 60th Cavalry Regiment, Coast Artillery Corps. He was reported captured by the Japanese on May 7, 1942. The last report received was Nov. 23, 1942, stating he died as prisoner of war. He is memorialized at Fort William McKinley, *Manila American Cemetery*, Philippines. He is also memorialized on a monument in *Oakdale Cemetery*
