McCarson was a Staff Sergeant in the U.S. Army Air Corps, 83rd Bomber Squadron, 12th Bomber Group. He was listed as missing in action July 11, 1944, in a bombing mission over Italy. He is memorialized at the Tablets of the Missing at <i>North Africa American Cemetery</i> , Carthage, Tunisia. He was born in Henderson County, the son of Milton Sevier McCarson and Lora Emma Jane Corn. He was working as a painter in Henderson County when he enlisted in 1942.
