The committee then discussed the historic properties inventory and talked about the idea of at least having a photo directory of each property even if the property owners were not interested in participating any further. It was discussed that the committee needs to work on composing design guidelines for Henderson County. The committee decided that each member should read Harnett Counties example of design guidelines. Another idea discussed was a future awards program and ceremony for individuals and / or organizations that strived to preserve historic property in Henderson County.
