Susan Sneeringer called the meeting to order at 3:05 P.M. and welcomed all in attendance.

**DISCUSSION ITEMS**

The minutes for June 17<sup>th</sup> meeting were approved.

Eric Warren updated the commission on the status of the St. Paul's Church application. The application was reviewed by NCDRC staff and comments were provided. A conference call will be set up with NCDRC staff to clarify some of the information required for a successful application.

Knox Crowell gave an update on the Polly King cabin. He has contacted the new owners of the property and they seem interested in preserving the cabin. Much of the owners time will be focused on restoring the home on the property, but they will be happy to find out more information on historic preservation. Some research needs to be done to determine if structure relocation has any effect on the landmark designation since the cabin is no longer in its original location, but was moved to the current location years ago. Knox will give new owners the Historic Resource Commission brochure for more information.

Stephen Fosberg asked the commission to reconsider the monthly meetings and return to the bi-monthly schedule for HRC meetings if there are no new developments.

Stephen Fosberg brought up possibility of looking into standards for landmark designation plaques.
