REVIEW MARCH MEETING MINUTES

The meeting focused on the discussion and decision on three different Certificates of Appropriateness for historic properties within the City of Hendersonville. The Commission reviewed two different COA cases from the meeting and discussed the decision-making process for approval and denial of COA's.

<u>Historic Henderson County Summer Camps:</u> Liz Hanson provided a presentation on historic summer camps within Henderson County. Ms. Hanson shared information on the summer camp, Camp Mondamin, located in Zirconia. The Commission discussed Camp Mondamin and a number of other summer camps that have been in operation for many years as well. The Commission also discussed the possibility of reaching out to summer camps regarding a potential historic program. The Commission discussed several potential resources for more information on historic summer camps in Henderson County and several members made plans to reach out to several different camp directors regarding their history.

UPDATES

Staff informed the commission that the Historic Resources Commission webpage on the Henderson County website has been updated and also contains information about the two County Historic Local Landmarks, St. Paul's Episcopal Church and the Samuel J. Childs House.

Staff also distributed brochures, previously discussed by the Commission, that contain information about the HRC and the Historic Local Landmarks program.
