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# Henderson County Parks & Recreation Community Needs Assessment Executive Summary

#### **Overview**

ETC Institute administered a community needs assessment for Henderson County during the Fall of 2019. The survey was administered as part of the County's efforts to determine priorities for parks, recreation facilities, program offerings, and special event offerings in the community. The survey and its results will guide the Henderson County Parks and Recreation Department in their ongoing efforts to grow and develop parks, facilities, and programs.

#### Methodology

ETC Institute mailed a survey packet to a random sample of households in Henderson County. Each survey packet contained a cover letter, a copy of the survey, and a postage-paid return envelope. Residents who received the survey were given the option of returning the survey by mail or completing it online at <a href="https://www.HendersonCountySurvey.org">www.HendersonCountySurvey.org</a>.

Ten days after the surveys were mailed, ETC Institute sent emails and placed phone calls to the households that received the survey to encourage participation. The emails contained a link to the online version of the survey to make it easy for residents to complete the survey. To prevent people who were not residents of Henderson County from participating, everyone who completed the survey online was required to enter their home address prior to submitting the survey. ETC Institute then matched the addresses that were entered online with the addresses that were originally selected for the random sample. If the address from a survey completed online did not match one of the addresses selected for the sample, the online survey was not counted.

The goal was to obtain completed surveys from at least 400 residents. The goal was exceeded with a total of 435 residents completing the survey. The overall results for the sample of 435 households have a precision of at least +/-4.69% at the 95% level of confidence.

The major findings of the survey are summarized below and on the following pages.

#### **Overall Use and Satisfaction with Parks and Facilities**

**Use.** Respondents were asked to select which parks and facilities they or members of their household had visited in the past 12 months, the most frequently visited parks/facilities, were: Jackson Park (61%) and East Flat Rock Park (41%). These parks/facilities were also the most used, as indicated by respondent households, with 65% of respondents indicating Jackson Park was used most and 41% indicating East Flat Rock Park was used most during the past 12 months. When questioned about the frequency respondents visited one or more of the Henderson County parks/facilities, four percent (4%) of respondent households indicated they visited 5 or more times a week, 23% indicated they go between 2 to 4 times a week, 16% visit once a week, 26% visit 1 to 3 times a week, and 32% visit less than once a month.

**Satisfaction.** Twenty-six percent (26%) of respondent households rated the quality and condition of Henderson County parks/facilities visited as "excellent," over half (59%) of respondents rated the quality and condition as "good," 12% gave a "fair" rating, and 3% rated the quality and condition as "poor."

#### **Overall Use and Satisfaction with Recreational Programs**

**Use.** Twenty-one percent (21%) of respondents indicated they or members of their household had participated in recreation programs offered by the Henderson County Parks and Recreation Department during the previous 12 months.

**Satisfaction.** Thirty-five percent (35%) of households who participated in Henderson County Parks and Recreation Department programs rated the overall quality of programs as "excellent," 54% gave an overall quality rating as "good," 10% gave an overall quality rating as "fair," and 1% gave a "poor" rating.

### **Barriers Preventing the Use of Facilities/Programs**

Respondents were asked from a list of 18 potential reasons to identify what prevents them from using facilities and programs operated by the Henderson County Parks and Recreation Department more often. The top four reasons were: I do not know what is being offered (43%), I do not know the locations of facilities (12%), Not interested in programs/facilities offered (12%), and no time to visit parks (11%).

#### **Greenways**

Twelve percent (12%) of respondent households indicated they have visited a greenway 25 times or more, 7% of respondents have visited 21 to 25 times, 8% of respondents have used a greenway 11 to 20 times, 12% have used a greenway 6 to 10 times, and 46% of respondent households have visited a greenway 1 to 5 times. Seven percent (7%) of respondent households indicated they or members of their households want to use greenways daily, 23% of respondents want to use greenways a few times a week, 31% of respondents want to use greenways a few times a month, 23% of respondents want to use greenways a few times a year, and 16% of respondent households never want to use greenways.


Respondents were asked from a list of eight potential reasons that discourage greenway use for respondent and members of respondents' household. The top three reasons were: lack of information about existing greenways (33%), lack of time (30%), and lack of nearby destinations (19%).

Assessment participants were asked to indicate the destinations that they and other members of their household would like to get to by greenway and over half (59%) indicated they would like to get to natural areas and open space, by greenway. Forty-eight (48%) of respondent households indicated they were like to get to parks and playgrounds by greenway and 37% of participants respondent that they would like to get to other greenways by greenway.


#### **Facility Needs and Priorities**

**Facility Needs**. Respondents were asked to identify if their household had a need for 30 recreation facilities and rate how well their needs for each were currently being met. Based on this analysis, ETC Institute was able to estimate the number of households in the community that had the greatest "unmet" need for various facilities.


The top three recreation facilities with the highest percentage of households that indicated a need for the facility were: multi-purpose natural trails (58%), greenway trail system (55%), and paved multi-use trails (50%). ETC Institute estimates a total of 26,133 households of the 45,448 households in Henderson County have a need for multi-purpose natural trails, an estimated 25,087 households of the 45,448 households in Henderson County have a need for a greenway trail system, and an estimated 22,769 households of the 45,448 households in Henderson County have a need for multi-use paved trails.



An estimated total of 17,169 households of the 45,448 households in Henderson County have unmet needs for multi-purpose natural trails, an estimated total of 16,482 households of the 45,448 households in Henderson County have unmet needs for a greenway trail system, an estimated total of 14,201 households of the 45,448 households in Henderson County have unmet needs for indoor fitness/exercise facilities, and an estimated 13,753 households of the 45,448 households in Henderson County have unmet needs for multi-use paved trails. The estimated number of households that have unmet needs for each of the 30 facilities that were assessed is shown in the table below.



**Facility Importance:** In addition to assessing the needs for each facility, ETC Institute also assessed the importance that residents placed on each facility. Based on the sum of respondents' top four choices, the four most important facilities to residents were: greenway trail system (33%), multi-use paved trails (30%), multi-purpose natural trails (27%), and multi-use unpaved trails (21%). The percentage of residents who selected each facility as one of their top four choices is shown in the chart at the top of the next page.




Priorities for Facility Investments: The Priority Investment Rating (PIR) was developed by ETC Institute to provide organizations with an objective tool for evaluating the priority that should be placed on Parks and Recreation investments. The Priority Investment Rating (PIR) equally weighs (1) the importance that residents place on facilities and (2) how many residents have unmet needs for the facility. [Details regarding the methodology for this analysis are provided in Section 2 of this report.]

Based the Priority Investment Rating (PIR), the following seven facilities were rated as high priorities for investment:

- Greenway trail system (PIR=196)
- Multi-purpose natural trails (PIR=183)
- Trails-Paved multi-use (PIR=170)
- Indoor fitness/exercise facilities (PIR=135)
- Aquatics/swimming facility (outdoor) (PIR=129)
- Trails-Unpaved multi-use (PIR=127)
- Dog park (PIR=115)




#### **Programming Needs and Priorities**

**Programming Needs**. Respondents were also asked to identify if their household had a need for 25 recreational programs and rate how well their needs for each program were currently being met. Based on this analysis, ETC Institute was able to estimate the number of households in the community that had "unmet" needs for each program.

The five programs with the highest percentage of households that had needs were: adult fitness and wellness programs (45%), community festivals (33%), senior wellness and fitness programs (33%), winter programs (26%), and kayak, canoe, paddleboard rentals (24%). ETC Institute estimates a total of 13,801 households out of the 45,448 households in Henderson County have unmet needs for community festivals, an estimated 11,707 households out of the 45,448 households in Henderson County have unmet needs for adult fitness and wellness programs, an estimated 8,418 households out of the 45,448 households in Henderson County have unmet needs for senior wellness and fitness programs, an estimated 6,442 households out of the 45,448 households in Henderson County have unmet needs for gardening, and an estimated 5,881 households out of the 45,448 households in Henderson County have unmet needs for volunteer opportunities. The estimated number of households that have unmet needs for each of the 25 programs that were assessed is shown in the chart at the top of the following page.




**Program Importance.** In addition to assessing the needs for each program, ETC Institute also assessed the importance that residents placed on each program. Based on the sum of respondents' top four choices, the four most important programs to residents were: adult fitness and wellness programs (31%), senior wellness and fitness programs (23%), community festivals (21%), and dog park programs (14%). The percentage of residents who selected each facility as one of their top four choices is shown in the chart at the top of the following page.



**Priorities for Programming Investments.** Based on the priority investment rating (PIR), which was described briefly on Page v of this Executive Summary and is described in more detail in Section 2 of this report, the following three programs were rated as "high priorities" for investment:

- Adult fitness and wellness programs (PIR=185)
- Community festivals (PIR=169)
- Senior wellness and fitness programs (PIR=135)

The chart at the top of the following page shows the Priority Investment Rating (PIR) for each of the 25 programs that were rated.



#### **Additional Findings**

Thirty-five percent (35%) of respondent households "feel" that there are sufficient parks and green space areas within a 10-minute walk from their residence. Fifty-one percent (51%) "feel" there are not enough parks and green space areas within a 10-minute walk from their household and 15% are not sure.

A substantial amount (74%) of respondents indicated they "feel" there are sufficient parks and green space areas within a 15-minute drive of their household, 15% "feel" there are not, and 11% are not sure.

Forty-one percent (41%) of households hear about Henderson County Parks and Recreation Department facilities and programs from friends, family, and coworkers, 18% of respondents use social media, and 16% of respondents use the Henderson County Parks website.

From a list of 17 potential indoor programming space that could be added or expanded, the top four programming spaces, as indicated by respondent households, were: walking and jogging track (44%), exercise facility for adults 50 years or older (38%), nature center (38%), and aerobics/fitness/dance class space (33%).

The highest level of support for tax dollars being used to fund various facilities, based on the combined "very supportive" and "somewhat supportive" responses among residents who had an

opinion, were: improve and add features to existing parks (71%), repair older structures and playgrounds (66%), make facilities accessible for persons of all abilities (66%), and additional greenways (65%). The top four actions that respondent households would be most willing to fund with Henderson County tax dollars, based on the sum of respondents' top four choices, were: improve and add features to existing parks (42%), additional greenways (36%), land purchase for new trails (32%), and repair older structures and playgrounds (30%).

#### Recommendations

To ensure that the Henderson County continues to meet the needs and expectations of the community, ETC Institute recommends that the Parks and Recreation Department sustain and/or improve the performance in areas that were identified as "high priorities" by the Priority Investment Rating (PIR). The amenities and programs with the highest PIR ratings are listed below.

#### **Facility Priorities**

- Greenway trail system (PIR=196)
- Multi-purpose natural trails (PIR=183)
- Trails-Paved multi-use (PIR=170)
- Indoor fitness/exercise facilities (PIR=135)
- Aquatics/swimming facility (outdoor) (PIR=129)
- Trails-Unpaved multi-use (PIR=127)
- Dog park (PIR=115)




# Q1. Please CHECK ALL of the following Henderson County Parks and Recreation Department parks and facilities you or members of your household have visited over the past 12 months.

by percentage of respondents (multiple choices could be made)




## Q2. Which THREE of the parks/facilities from the list in Question 1 does your household use MOST

by percentage of respondents who selected the items as one of their top three choices




# Q3. In the past 12 months, how often have you or other members of your household visited one or more of the Henderson County parks/facilities listed in Question 1?




## Q4. Overall, how would you rate the quality and condition of ALL the Henderson County parks/facilities that you have visited?







## Q5. Do you feel that there are sufficient parks and green space areas within a 10-minute walk of your residence?




## Q6. Do you feel that there are sufficient parks and green space areas within a 15-minute drive of your residence?









# Q7a. How would you rate the overall quality of Henderson County Parks and Recreation Department programs that you and members of your household have participated in?






## Q10. In the past 12 months, approximately how many times have you or members of your household visited any greenway?

by percentage of respondents (without "not provided")




## Q11. How often do you or other members of your household WANT to use greenways?

by percentage of respondents (without "not provided")




## Q12. Please CHECK ALL of the following reasons that discourage greenway use for you or other members of your household.

by percentage of respondents (multiple choices could be made)




## Q13. Please CHECK ALL of the following destinations that you or other members of your household would most like to get to by greenway.


## Q14. Please indicate if you or members of your household have a need for each of the facilities listed below.

## Q14. Estimated Number of Households That Have a Need for Various Facilities



## Q14. How Well Facilities Meet the Needs of Respondent Households


by percentage of respondents with a need for facilities


## Q14. Estimated Number of Households Whose Needs for Facilities **Are Being Met 50% or Less**


## Q15. Facilities Most Important to Households

by percentage of respondents who selected the items as one of their top four choices




## Q16. Facilities Households Use Most

by percentage of respondents who selected the items as one of their top four choices




## Q17. Programs Respondent Households Have a Need For




## Q17. Estimated Number of Households Whose Needs for Programs Are Being Met 50% or Less


### Q18. Programs That Are Most Important to Households

by percentage of respondents who selected the items as one of their top four choices




### Q19. Programs Households Participate in Most Often

by percentage of respondents who selected the items as one of their top four choices






### Q21. Please indicate how supportive you would be of having Henderson County use your tax dollars to fund each of the following.

by percentage of respondents




# Q22. Which FOUR of the actions listed in Question 21 would you be MOST WILLING to fund with your Henderson County tax dollars?

by percentage of respondents who selected the items as one of their top four choices





by percentage of respondents




### Q25. Including yourself, how many people in your household are...

by percentage of respondents (without "not provided")




### **Q26. Your gender:**





### Q27. Which of the following best describes your race?

by percentage of respondents (without "not provided")




### Q28. How long have you lived in Henderson County?






### Q29. Are you a year-round resident Henderson County?

# Section 2 Benchmarking Analysis

### **Benchmarking Summary Report Henderson County, North Carolina**

Since 1998, ETC Institute has conducted household surveys for needs assessments, feasibility studies, customer satisfaction, fees and charges comparisons, and other parks and recreation issues in more than 400 communities in 49 states across the country.

The results of these surveys has provided an unparalleled data base of information to compare responses from household residents in client communities to "National Averages" and therefore provide a unique tool to "assist organizations in better decision making."

Communities within the data base include a full-range of municipal and county governments from 20,000 in population through over 1 million in population. They include communities in warm weather climates and cold weather climates, mature communities and some of the fastest growing cities and counties in the country.

"National Averages" have been developed for numerous strategically important parks and recreation planning and management issues including: customer satisfaction and usage of parks and programs; methods for receiving marketing information; reasons that prevent members of households from using parks and recreation facilities more often; priority recreation programs, parks, facilities and trails to improve or develop; priority programming spaces to have in planned community centers and aquatic facilities; potential attendance for planned indoor community centers and outdoor aquatic centers; etc.

Results from household responses for Henderson County, North Carolina were compared to National Benchmarks to gain further strategic information. A summary of all tabular comparisons are shown on the following page.

# Section 3 Priority Investment Rating

### **Priority Investment Rating Henderson County, North Carolina**

The **Priority Investment Rating (PIR)** was developed by ETC Institute to provide governments with an objective tool for evaluating the priority that should be placed on parks and recreation investments. The Priority Investment Rating was developed by ETC Institute to identify the facilities and programs residents think should receive the highest priority for investment. The priority investment rating reflects the importance residents place on items (sum of top 4 choices) and the unmet needs (needs that are only being partly or not met) for each facility/program relative to the facility/program that rated the highest overall. Since decisions related to future investments should consider both the level of unmet need and the importance of facilities and programs, the PIR weights each of these components equally.

The PIR reflects the sum of the Unmet Needs Rating and the Importance Rating as shown in the equation below:

PIR = UNR + IR

For example, suppose the Unmet Needs Rating for outdoor tennis courts is 14 (out of 100) and the Importance Rating for outdoor tennis courts is 7 (out of 100), the Priority Investment Rating for outdoor tennis courts would be 21 (out of 200).

#### **How to Analyze the Charts:**


- **High Priority Areas** are those with a PIR of at least 100. A rating of 100 or above generally indicates there is a relatively high level of unmet need and residents generally think it is important to fund improvements in these areas. Improvements in this area are likely to have a positive impact on the greatest number of households.
- Medium Priority Areas are those with a PIR of 50-99. A rating in this range generally
  indicates there is a medium to high level of unmet need or a significant percentage of
  residents generally think it is important to fund improvements in these areas.
- Low Priority Areas are those with a PIR below 50. A rating in this range generally indicates there is a relatively low level of unmet need and residents do not think it is important to fund improvements in these areas. Improvements may be warranted if the needs of very specialized populations are being targeted.




#### **Importance Rating for Recreation Facilities**


### Top Priorities for Investment for Facilities Based on the Priority Investment Rating




