



Henderson County wants your input on the draft Land Development Code!

The Henderson County Board of Commissioners plan to hold a series of public input sessions to receive comments from the public regarding the proposed draft Land Development Code (LDC) and zoning map. **This is your opportunity to voice your support, concerns, or suggestions for the draft LDC and zoning map.**

Beginning March 20, 2007 the Commissioners will hold a public input session every Tuesday night at 7pm for five consecutive weeks. The input sessions will conclude with a public hearing on Tuesday, April 24, 2007 at 7pm. Planning staff will be available each night at 6pm to answer questions on an individual basis. The input sessions will be held in different locations in the County to provide the most convenient opportunities for you to attend. Henderson County residents are encouraged to attend any of the sessions listed below.
