

## Short Term Consequences of Tobacco Use

- Bad breath/zoo breath
- Yellow teeth and fingers
- Less money to spend
- Clothes stink
- Difficult to run and short of breath
- Burn holes and chew
- Stains
- Coughing/hacking phlegm
- Ashes & butts everywhere
- Tooth abrasion











# Long Term Consequences of Tobacco Use/Abuse

- Cancer
  - Oropharynx
  - Larynx
  - Esophagus
  - Lung
  - Leukemia
  - Stomach
  - Liver
  - Pancreas
  - Kidney
  - Bladder
  - Colorectal

- Heart Disease
- Diabetes
- Respiratory Diseases
- Blindness/Cataracts
- Stroke
- Birth Defects from maternal smoking
- Overall Bad Health

How difficult was it to breathe?

Non-smoker's lungs










### **Chewing Tobacco**

### The Real Deal

#### How much does tobacco cost?

#### 1 pack of cigarettes or 1 can of chew = \$4

How much per week?

(\$4 per pack/can x 7 days = \$28 per wk)

How much per month?

(\$28 per wk x 4 wks = \$112 per month)

How much per year?

(\$28 per wk x 52 weeks = \$1,456 per yr)

\$ per day x 365 days x 50 years =
 \$73.000











# Other ways to spend money















# They put WHAT in there???

More than <u>5,000 chemicals</u> are in cigarette smoke. <u>More than 40</u> of those ingredients are known to <u>cause cancer</u>.

#### Some are:

- Nicotine used as a pesticide
- Polonium 210 nuclear waste
- Cadium used in car batteries
- Lead a nerve poison
- Uranium 235 found in nuclear weapons

- Formaldehyde in embalming fluid
- Arsenic rat poison
- Cyanide poison
- Acetone found in nail polish remover
- Ammonia used in cleaning products

AND....fertilizer, dead bugs, manure, pesticides and dirt!









# WHY Do They Put That In There??

... I thought tobacco was natural.

To turn experimenters into ADDICTS!

- Symptoms of dependence begin soon after the 1<sup>st</sup> "puff"!!!!!
- 4 full fledged attempts!!!
