All applicants please note: You will be subject to a National Crime Computer background check and applicants with a significant history of problems will be rejected. Driving While Impaired (DWI) and/or a revoked driver's license are examples of such problems. Minor traffic violations are not normally reasons for exclusion. The Sheriff retains sole discretion on excluding applicants from the program.

All applicants will be contacted by an Academy representative prior to the first class session. Classes are held on Tuesday evenings (beginning January), 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm for 13 consecutive weeks plus a graduation ceremony and dinner. Class location is at the Law Enforcement Center, 100 N. Grove St. Hendersonville, N.C. The date, time and location of the graduation will be announced.

A fee of **\$30.00, payable at the first class session**, covers all class materials, the graduation dinner for the student and a diploma. Optional Sheriff's Citizens Academy logo shirts and/or jackets are available for purchase. Local checks are the only accepted means of payment.
