PRESERVATION AGREEMENT

_____ This preservation Agreement may be revoked by the property owner with written notice to the Henderson County Agricultural Advisory Board or by this Board if the property owner fails to abide by the requirements stated in Henderson County's Code of Ordinances, Chapter 45.

For purposes of determining whether a property is being used for bona fide farm purposes, any of the following is sufficient evidence that the property is being used for bona fide farm purposes according to NC General Statute 106D-903(a):

- (1) A farm sales tax exemption certificate issued by the Department of Revenue.
(2) A copy of the property tax listing showing that the property is eligible for participation in the present-use value program pursuant to G.S. 105-277.3.
(3) A copy of the farm owner's or operator's Schedule F from the owner's or operator's most recent federal income tax return.
(4) A forest management plan.
