

HENDERSON COUNTY FOAM COLLECTION PILOT PROGRAM

FOAM CAN BE DROPPED OFF AT THE CONVENIENCE CENTER ON SPECIAL COLLECTION DAYS, TYPICALLY THE FIRST AND THIRD TUESDAY OF EACH MONTH.

MUST BE A HENDERSON COUNTY RESIDENT.

FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES BEFORE DROPPING OFF FOAM:



1

Empty the container
(Rinse if the item contains food or liquid residue).

2

Ensure containers are clean and dry. Remove any tape or stickers. Do not bag foam items.

3

Bring to the Henderson County Convenience Center during a foam collection event. Typically the second Tuesday of the month.

4

Place in appropriate recycling receptacle at the Convenience Center. No household trash or other recycling is acceptable in the foam collection bin.

FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES TO KNOW WHAT TYPES OF FOAM ARE ACCEPTED:



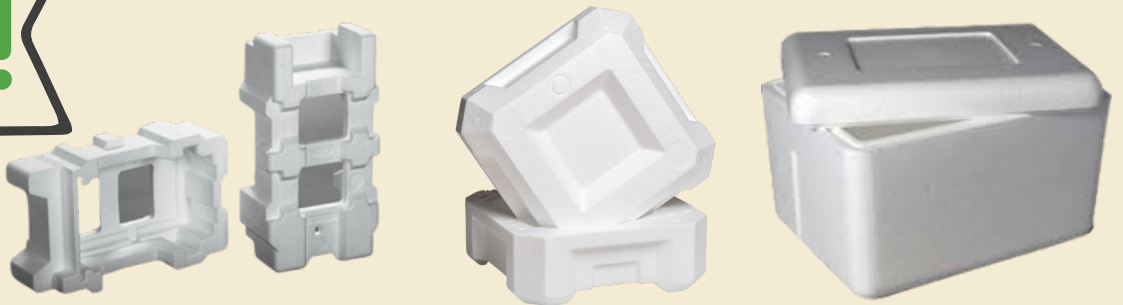
YES!

Clean and dry foodservice packaging including clamshell take out containers, cups, meat packing trays, egg cartons, and plates.



YES!

Rigid foam packing materials including foam from electronics, appliances, furniture, or valuables and foam coolers.



NO!

Foam covered in food residue, foam with tape and stickers.



NO!

Foam packing peanuts, foam pipe insulation, floral foam, soft/flexible foam.
