- Run Risk of Fines by Not Complying with State Bans (DNR)
- No Improvement in Recycle Recovery Rate
- · Continue to Receive Citizen Complaints about Lack of Recycle Facilities

  - 2.) Low Operational Cost to County
  - Lower Tipping Fees for Haulers
- · Con
  - 1,) Reduced Price for Recycle Materials
  - 2.) Without Compacting High Transportation Cost
  - 3.) Possible Higher Capital Cost for Haulers

#### 2.) County to Construct a Clean MRF

#### **Process Description**

- · Input:
  - 1.) Single Stream All Recyclables Commingled
  - 2.) Dual Stream
    - Paper
    - Containers
- · Output: Separate, Compacted, Sorted Materials Shipped to Recycle Buyer

#### **Evaluation**

- · Pro's
  - 1) Higher Revenues from Recycling
  - 2.) Lower Tipping fees for haulers
- · Con
  - 1,) High Capital Investment for County
  - 2.) High Operational Cost for County
  - 3.) Possible Higher Capital Cost to Haulers
  - 4.) High Financial Risk to County If Facility Not Utilized

#### 3.) County to Construct MSW Incinerator

**Process Description**: High Temperature Combustion of MSW

#### Evaluation

- · Pro's
  - 1) Significant Volume Reduction of MSW
- Con
  - 1.) Destroys Recyclables: Paper & Plastic Containers Unless Preceded by Dirty MRF
  - 2.) Creates Air Pollution
  - 3.) Wasteful Process Heat Energy Released to Atmosphere
  - 4,) High Capital Investment
  - 5.) Very High Operational Cost (\$100/Ton)
  - 6.) Need to Dispose of Ash
  - 7.) Very Difficult Permitting Process
  - 8.) Site Location Critical: (NIMBY)
