TX-2022-01 Flood Damage Prevention

Natalie Berry, Henderson County Site Development Director, provided a brief overview of the proposed text amendment. The current Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance allows up to 20% fill in the flood fringe. The proposed text amendment would remove the 20% fill maximum and allow 100% fill within the flood fringe area. All development or improvements within the flood fringe area would still require a flood damage prevention permit.

Crystal Lyda recommended forwarding the proposed text amendment as presented. Kevin Waldrup seconded the motion. All members voted in favor.
