**Discussion**

Recognition of Mr. Jim Crafton. Mrs. Kumor took a moment to recognize Mr. Jim Crafton for his years of service to the Henderson County TAC after announcing that he had stepped down from his role on the committee.

Approval of Agenda. Mrs. Kumor asked to have the Public Comments moved from the bottom of the agenda to the first formal item. Request was approved unanimously.

Public Comment. Mrs. Kumor opened the floor for public comment. Citizens expressed concerns on the current NCDOT projects on US64W, Kanuga Rd., and Highland Lake Rd. Information provided by citizens and board members are included in the minutes below.

Nomination of New Vice-Chair. Mrs. Renee Kumor made a motion to nominate the Mr. Beau Waddell for the position of Vice-Chair for the Henderson County TAC. Mr. John Dockendorf seconded the motion. All members voted in favor.

Review of FBRMPO Corridor Study Program. MPO Staff updated the committee that the Henderson County Board of Commissioners had chosen not to participate in the proposed Corridor Study Program at this time.

Presentation on the Balfour Parkway Project. Kristina Miller from RK&K gave a presentation and answered questions on the proposed Balfour Parkway Project. Information distributed that accompanied this presentation is included in the minutes below. All information should be considered a draft only.

## **Routine Updates**

Municipal Representatives. Councilman George Banta provided the committee with a copy of information Laurel Park recently provided to its residents. This handout is included in the minutes below.

Councilman George Banta updated the group on the status of its Bike/Ped Plan, saying that it is nearing completion.

Councilman John Dockendorf noted that Bike/Ped Plan for Historic Flat Rock is under review for potential updates.

Joe Sanders informed the committee that the Bike/Ped plan for the City of Hendersonville had recently been formally adopted.

Vice Chair Beau Waddell suggested that Laurel Park and stakeholders regarding the US64W Project find a time to meet and discuss concerns, alternatives, and opportunities. The committee agreed, and Mrs. Kumor took responsibility for organizing this meeting. A report on this meeting will be given at the next TAC meeting.
